I receive a rental increase each year to offset the cost of the upkeep of the property, including taxes, insurance maintenance but not limited too as well as community resident events. Whatever rentals increase I receive goes back to the residents and the property. I oppose the S.B. 143 because it would fundamentally alter the relationship between me and my residents. Meaning that a lease is a contract with a mutually start and end date, and this bill violates on the most fundamental property rights, and which is the right of control. By control I do not mean controlling the whims of my residents' daily lives but control and manage the property in a way that maintains the property in its highest and best use.
