3. **Consider input type**
 - Working with images, PDFs, or long documents? Use a multimodal model like GPT-4o

Many experts recommend starting with a versatile model like GPT-4o for most everyday tasks, then switching only if you need deeper reasoning.

- **Drafting a parent communication:** Use a fast/general model
- **Analyzing tuition trends or financial projections:** Use a reasoning model
- **Summarizing a board packet:** Start with general, switch to reasoning if nuance is needed
- **Developing a strategic plan:** Use a reasoning model for deeper insights

The Future: You Won't Always Have to Choose

Newer systems are beginning to automatically select the best model based on your prompt, reducing the need for manual decisions. However, understanding *why* a model works well is still essential for getting the best results—and for teaching others in your organization.
