Group Volunteer Opportunities (8 or more people)

Step 1: Visit www.acfb.org/volunteer

Step 2: Complete a Group Volunteer Request Form at <https://www.acfb.org/group-volunteer-form/>. Please ensure that you note in the comment section this request is for Food-A-Thon.

**Note: The Hunger Action Center has been reserved September 21st to September 26th. You're welcome to book shifts before AAA Impact Week, but those dates are available to the public, and we cannot guarantee specific availability.*

If you're looking for something closer to your office, smaller groups, sized 12-14, are welcome to serve at our Community Food Centers located in Atlanta off MLK Drive, Jonesboro, Marietta, and Stone Mountain. Please use the [Group Volunteer Request Form](#) to request one of these shifts. Please note that these shifts have not been reserved and are subject to availability.

Step 3: The Food Bank's Volunteer Team will follow up with you to confirm availability of the shift and reservation. Included will be a unique registration link for your team, details for the shift, and the Food Bank's address.

Step 4: Each team member MUST register themselves individually prior to the shift using your unique team registration link. In order to accurately track volunteer hours for Food-A-Thon, we will not take walk up volunteers.

Individual Volunteer Opportunities

If you have team members who would like to serve on their own or are unable to join your group, they are welcome to serve as individuals. Please have them sign up at <https://vhub.at/FoodAThon> using their work email.

If they sign up on our public site or without their work email, we will not be able to track their hours with your company.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Can I still volunteer if I cannot stay the entire shift?

Volunteers must stay for the entire shift to ensure we have enough hands to wrap up our project. If you have a team member not able to stay the full shift, please ask them to register for another date and time that fits their schedule.

Am I able to volunteer if I arrive late?

It is very important that volunteers arrive on time for their volunteer shift so we can maximize our efforts. Volunteers more than 30 minutes late for a volunteer shift will be unable to serve with us. While we do have a grace period, we ask that you make arriving on time a priority. We know Atlanta traffic can be challenging, so please make sure to give yourself enough time to get to our facility in case your commute is delayed.

Can we bring food to eat before or after our shift?

The Atlanta Community Food Bank does have conference space that groups may book to host meetings or eat before/after their volunteer shift at our main facility. Room space is subject to availability. If you would like access to our space, please let the Volunteer team know when setting up your volunteer shift.

Can my group bring a photographer to take pictures during our shift?

Absolutely. Just make sure to let the Volunteer team know when setting up your shift.

How many meals will my volunteer service count for in the Food-a-Thon competition?

The 2026 value of a volunteer hour in the state of Georgia is \$35.22. The Food Bank can provide 3 meals for every \$1 donated. For simplicity, AAA will apply the same impact formula for financial gifts to donated volunteer hours. Therefore, every hour served will count for 105 meals. ($\$35.22 \times 3$).
