

Strand Networking: these networking rooms allow attendees interested in similar thematic areas (known as "strands") to meet one another and discuss their shared interests. There are 22 strands in AAAL. These informal Strand Networking sessions are scheduled at 8-9 a.m. & 8-9 p.m. EDT on Sunday and/or Monday, for people especially interested in language cognition and brain research prior to the colloquium on that same topic. There is no advance signing up required to attend, no strand membership, no preparation, and no moderator, although selected graduate student volunteers will be moving across these rooms to see how they're functioning. There are also a few OPEN NETWORKING rooms for anyone to attend. For all of these rooms, the maximum capacity is 30 people per room. If one is full, try going to another. Tell your friends to meet you in one of the rooms if you like (first-come, first-admitted).

Note that just one room will be available at each time shown below unless we have indicated "2 (concurrent) rooms". For larger strands or those that have been combined, we have allocated more rooms. We hope you find these rooms conducive to informal interaction. Get to know one another and talk about which sessions you have found interesting so far!
