The AAGO Foundation educational scholarship provides financial assistance to eligible AAGO members looking to pursue higher education in the multi-family housing industry. The scholarship covers NAAEI Designations (CAM, CAPS, CAMT, CALP, CAS), EPA, CPO, Future Leaders, or L.E.A.P. To be considered a candidate for the scholarship, review the qualifications, complete the attached application, and sign below.

- Applicants must be employed by a community that is current and in good standing with the Apartment Association of Greater Orlando.
- Applicants need to have a **minimum of 12 months of experience** in the multi-family industry.
- Applicants cannot be eligible for; or receive monetary assistance for NAAEI designations, Future Leaders, L.E.A.P., EPA or CPO from their employer.
- Applicants must provide a brief essay with the application. The essay should include why you would like to be considered for the scholarship, how completing the desired course will positively impact your career in the multi-family industry and future career goals set for yourself.
- All applicants being considered for the scholarship will be interviewed. The interview may be via phone or in person.
- The scholarship will be used to cover fees related to the course in which you are enrolled. The AAGO Foundation does not reimburse for mileage or lost wages as a result of attending the required courses.
- The AAGO Foundation asks that anyone awarded scholarship funds give back to the AAGO Foundation by volunteering at a charity partner day of giving. (Contact Melanie for details)
- Recipients of the scholarship are required to abide by the attendance policies of the course and successfully complete any testing requirements within 6 months of course completion. **Failure to complete the course requirements will result in the recipient being financially responsible for all costs associated with the course at the member rate. APASS pricing will not be honored.**
- By investing in the education of future multi-family housing professionals, the AAGO Foundation Education Scholarship program helps to ensure the continued success and growth of the industry.
- Recipients may be asked for written or verbal feedback to further promote scholarship opportunities available through the AAGO Foundation.
