LEAD provides a complete development curriculum for current and aspiring property managers, leasing and maintenance professionals and supplier partners. Each certification requires completion of all requirements set by the AAKC Education Committee. This program can be achieved in one year with a maximum 2-year completion requirement. You must complete one of the NAA credential programs such as CALP, CAM, CAMT, CAPS, Supplier Success, or previously received CAS to receive your LEAD.
