The LEAD Certification is an honorary distinction accredited by the Apartment Association of Kansas City. LEAD provides a complete development curriculum for current and aspiring property managers, leasing professionals, maintenance professionals, and supplier partners. LEAD is designed to recognize the development efforts of professionals upon completion of a specific track.

The AAKC is offering LEAD certifications for Management Professionals, Leasing Professionals, Maintenance Professionals, and Supplier Partners. Each certification requires completion of all requirements set by the AAKC Professional Development and Education Committee. This program can be achieved in one year with a maximum of a 2-year completion requirement. You must complete one of the NAA credential programs such as CALP, CAM, CAMT, CAPS, previously received CAS or taken Supplier Success to receive your LEAD certification.

Whether you are a current or future NAA credential holder, the LEAD program provides a pathway to your success. By attending seminars, obtaining NAA credentials, and volunteering with the AAKC, you will obtain the LEAD distinction in your area of expertise recognized by industry leaders.
