

## **Notes from Statewide Multifamily Housing Industry on Hurricane Helene Relief** **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**

### **1. Water Update**

According to [this article from Blue Ridge Public Radio](#), it will most likely be mid-December before potable drinking water returns to the Asheville area. The current filtration system at the North Fork “does not have the capacity to treat the full amount necessary to flush the system and return drinking water to the city” so the US Army Corps of Engineers plans to build mobile filtration systems to help reduce the sediment.
