

The **Apartment Association of Orange County (AAOC) Summer Cruise** is right around the corner! We look forward to an enjoyable, fun-filled evening with you on **Thursday, August 3, from 5:30 to 8 p.m.**, onboard the legendary vessel **“Endless Dreams,”** where delicious appetizers, cheese station, champagne, drinks, and a live DJ await us!

**AAOC wristbands act as your “ticket” to board** and are necessary **to be visible/worn by all members of your party** upon arrival and boarding. This step will provide an expedient and efficient boarding process. If you have not already done so, please reach out to Sandy Gimpelson to schedule a day/time for pick-up at the AAOC office on: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday’s from: 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. **All wristbands should be distributed to everyone in the party ahead of time.**

**“Endless Dreams”** is docked at City Experiences/ Hornblower Cruises at: **2431 W. Coast Highway, Newport Beach, CA 92663.** [See attached sheet for driving instructions.](#) You may board the vessel at 5:15 p.m., perhaps earlier, at the direction of the captain, and enjoy a complimentary glass of champagne on the second level, prior to our departure. Please note, we will depart the dock promptly at **5:30 p.m.**

**Very limited parking is available** in the **wrap-around parking area**, adjacent to the dock, at a cost of \$10 CASH. Another option to consider is self- park at the Balboa Bay Club and walk over to the dock. It is \$10 for three hours, and \$6 for each additional hour. Valet parking is \$20. There is always the option of carpooling or Uber. Fashion Island may be a good spot to park/Uber.

**Public parking is available along PCH and across the street in a City Parking Lot.** The public parking lot has pay stations where drivers can pay with quarters or download the ParkMobile app to pay with credit card. Parking rates vary. The mobile parking app is <http://us.parkmobile.com/>

Once you arrive at the dock, turn left, look for AAOC signage, and please check in at the registration desk, and receive your complimentary drink ticket.

Finally, for guests who wish to purchase additional drinks during the cruise, **cash and credit cards will be accepted at the bars** located on two decks of Endless Dreams. Do know that the credit card machines are known to be glitchy. To avoid stress, bring cash, just to be on the safe side.

## DRIVING & PARKING HORNBLOWER SOUTH

2431 West Coast Highway, Newport Beach, California 92663

### PARKING

There is limited on-site parking available on Monday-Friday evenings, Saturdays and Sundays. Price per car is \$10.00 January-November and \$15 in December. Cash only accepted. Please make sure to give yourself plenty of time to find parking if you have not arranged drop-off transportation.

### BOARDING

Please wait on the waterfront walkway for your cruise. Boarding is not permitted until directed by a captain or Crew Member. Please do not board at your own discretion. Thank you!



### FROM SAN DIEGO (405), SANTA ANA(5), OR CORONA DEL MAR (73) FREEWAYS

- Take the Costa Mesa (55) Freeway South, towards Newport Beach
- The Freeway ends and merges into Newport Blvd
- Continue on Newport Blvd for 2 miles
- After Hospital Road, take the right-hand exit for Highway 1
- At the bottom of the hill, make a left at the light for Pacific Coast Hwy (Hwy 1)
- Pass thru stoplights at Riverside Ave and Tustin Ave
- Hornblower is located on the right side  
*If you get to A'maree's you have gone too far.*

### FROM JAMBOREE

- Take Jamboree south towards Pacific Coast Highway
- Make a right onto Pacific Coast Hwy and continue for approximately 2 miles
- Turn left into Hornblower, immediately after passing A'maree's  
*If you get to the stoplight at Tustin Ave you have gone too far.*

Although it is possible to use Newport Blvd to the PCH, alternate routes are highly recommended, especially in summer months and December.

**For your safety: Please do not jaywalk, use the designated crosswalks on Tustin Avenue**
