☆ How to Use your Committee Dedicated Dropbox:

- Preview or download files: Click on any document to review in Dropbox, or right-click to download
- Upload Files: Use this dedicated upload link or click into a folder to directly upload a file
 - Please follow staff instructions for where to place items, and please avoid dragging files directly into folders unless asked.
- Editing Documents: Many files are PDFs or read-only. If collaborative editing is needed, the document will not show up as read-only.
 - o Links may be provided for specific collaborative purposes.

☑ Board Dropbox Etiquette

- When using the direct upload portal please rename your uploaded files with your name and document type: (LastName_FirstName_DocType_SubmissionDate)
- Check file dates and titles before opening or commenting
- Use the dedicated <u>BOD Upload Portal</u> instead of dragging files into folders unless otherwise instructed
- Keep communication professional in any comments or shared notes
- If you are having difficulties or need one on one guidance, please reach out.

X DON'T:

- Upload blank or duplicate forms
- · Edit files directly unless explicitly asked to
- Rename or move existing documents
- · Add personal notes or unrelated files
- Panic we're here to help!

Pro Tips:

- Bookmark your Dropbox link in your browser for easy access
- File names include dates for quick reference: YYYY-MM-DD_DocumentType_Name.pdf
- You may be asked to log in to Dropbox to view certain files a free account is fine
