


Q1 Has your state issued guidelines for the re-entry of school in the fall?

Q2 What state is your district in?













Q4 Do you have a deadline for making decisions on how school will look in the fall?





Q5 Are you planning on Teacher (non-classified) layoffs/furloughs for the fall? (Check all that apply)





Q6 Are you planning on increasing your Teacher (non-classified) staff in the fall?





Q7 Are you delaying your Teacher (non-classified) staff hiring for the fall?





Q8 Are you planning on Classified layoffs/furloughs for the fall? (Check all that apply)





Q9 Are you planning on increasing your Classified staff in the fall? (Check all that apply)





Q10 Are you delaying your Classified staff hiring for the fall?





Q11 Have you made any formal agreements with your teachers and/or unions regarding working conditions for the 2020-2021 school year?





Q12 Have you currently made adjustments to your benefits package (excluding pay) for employees?





Q13 What adjustments have you made to your benefits (excluding pay) package? (Check all that apply)




