AATF-AFS SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP

AFS-USA and the AATF are proud to celebrate French language and culture by awarding a \$7,500 scholarship to a current U.S. high school student interested in broadening their understanding of the Francophone world and strengthening their French language skills through an authentic experience abroad. This scholarship provides AATF members an opportunity to recognize promising high school students through a nomination for an immersive 4-week experience at the AFS France Summer Language Camp in 2026.



Student Eligibility

Who?

- Minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Be between the age of 15 and 16 years 11 months at the time of the program start (June 28, 2026). Nominees' birthdates should be between July 28 2009 - June 28 2011.
- Must be nominated by December 3, 2025 by a French teacher who is a member of the AATF.
- Minimum raw, combined score of 40 on the 2026 *Grand Concours*/National French Contest



Scholarship Information

What?

- Merit- and need-based
- One (1) award of \$7,500
- Scholarship allows for participation in the AFS France Summer Language Camp in June/July 2026.



Application Process

How?

- AATF member teachers nominate students by December 3, 2025 via the AATF website (members must be logged-in to their accounts to access the nomination form)
- Finalists announced in January
- Winner and runner-up announced in early April
