## Culinary and Food Terms Game: Answers

1. **Soufflé** ( Sue Flay) –A **soufflé** is a light, fluffy, baked dish made with egg yolks and beaten egg whites and other ingredients
2. **Chateaubriand** (Chateau Brie And) **Chateaubriand steak** is a recipe of a particular thick cut from the tenderloin
3. **Tournedos** (Turn Do) **Tournedos** is a dish of sirloin steak with Madeira sauce with pâté de foie gras on top.
4. **Steak Tartare** ( Stay K Tartar) – **Steak tartare** is a meat dish made from finely chopped or ground raw beef or horse meat. Usually it is served with a raw egg on top.
5. **Baguette** ( Bag Ette) - a long loaf of crusty French bread
6. **Camembert** ( Cam Um Bear) – a French cheese made in the north of France
7. **Croque monsieur** ( Croak Monsieur) – a glorified ham and cheese sandwich made with special cheeses and grated melted cheese on top
8. **Orangina** ( Orange Gina) – an orange soda drink with some orange juice and pulp in it
9. **Jambon** ( Jam Bone) – ham
10. **Laitue** (Lay Two) - lettuce
