Excerpts From Annual Reports

Maury HS (Va.)

The SHF attended a reception to meet Valérie-Anne Giscard d'Estaing who came to their area to become Queen Azalea; also participated in a kermesse sponsored by the local Alliance Française.

Emma Sansom HS (Ala.)

Each year at Christmas, members vote on the amount each will contribute for the purchase of toys. A committee is appointed by the president to purchase toys. These toys are given to the Salvation Army for distribution to the poor.

This year new members were inducted by the old members going to the classrooms and pinning a carnation on the student to be inducted. Each was given an invitation to attend the meeting of the chapter to be held that day. During the meeting certificates of membership were given, followed by a reception.

Wildwood Catholic (NJ)

The SHF attended the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in the French language, at school, with the members of the chapter taking the leading offices in this liturgical function.

Central Sr. HS (Md.)

Our main activity was helping to sponsor and implement Lingo-Snack, an event involving all foreign languages in the school. During one of our bi-weekly one-hour lunches, four mini-courses were in operation during which anyone who pleased came to learn a minimal travel vocabulary in the language of his choice. After practicing about twenty useful phrases, the learners could go to the café corner and order in the new language a snack typical of that country. Thus, the learners of French could order several varieties of French cheese with crackers and non-alcoholic "wine," red or white. The Spanish had Dorito chips and bean dip. The Germans served pretzels and root beer. The Latin students did not make their pupils speak the language, but served a real treat--homemade baklava. All "teachers" and waiters were students. The customers paid a nominal fee for the food. The county supervisory staff all came to visit and participate. In short, the event was a success and may become an annual affair by popular demand.

Sacred Heart Academy (Ky.)

This year, the SHF of Sacred Heart A. has involved its members in many different activities along with the usual meetings. "Le concours de cuisine" was held at the beginning of the year giving everyone a chance to display his talent in preparing French cuisine. Members of the SHF have also viewed the movie "La Belle et la bête." At Christmas a mass was celebrated in French with the participation of the French students of Trinity HS, a neighboring school. A French exchange student came to talk to us about French customs, culture and everyday life.

Forbush HS (NC)

During foreign language emphasis week in NC, members of the FORBUSH SHF prepared a complete French meal for the Spanish III and IV classes. The Spanish III and IV in turn prepared a Spanish meal for members of the SHF. It was a very good experience for these two groups to share the food that is part of two cultures which are so different.

Rogers HS (Ohio)

Our year's activities began with the annual "Promenade à Bicyclette" with the French Club. The members packed lunches, and we were off to a local park for fun and games, including a pétanques tournament. Our "Voyage de Foin" (Hayride) was a success, and brought many prospective Honorary members out. Our members performed various folk dances from France for various schools. Our last activity, our banquet, took place April 22. The title was "Une Soirée à Paris," and each member was required to make a French dish to bring. The result was a six-course, typically French dinner, with first and second year French non-members being the "garçons," and the new members being "les plongeurs."

Carbondale Area HS (Pa.)

During a span of 8 weeks, students enjoyed watching the series "Toute la Bande" on the Education Channel.

Baylor School (Tn.)

(not an SHF activity, but some of you may be interested in this publication which Mrs. Schéni was kind enough to mention...) "JANUS" A DICTIONARY OF 5,000 WORDS ALIKE IN FRENCH AND ENGLISH. is available for \$3.00 from the Baylor School, P.O. 1137, Chattanooga, Tn. Attn: Bruce High, Librarian. The work was prepared by Mireille Schéni, a graduate of the Alliance Française and a member of the faculties of the Baylor School and the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga.

Notre Dame HS (Ct.)

Work done by the SHF: a UNICEF party for the faculty which collected \$63 for the children in underprivileged countries; a Christmas party for retarded children.

Stratford HS (Ct.)

For Parents' Night, the SHF helped the French Club sponsor a cheese and cider table for the annual display of activity booths. A selection of French cheeses was awarded as door prizes.

On February 11, 1975, the French and Spanish Clubs and Honor Societies sponsored the annual Mardi Gras attended by 250-300 people. Booths representing foods from many countries served dinner from 5:30 to 7:00 pm. International dancing took place in the gymnasium from 7:30 to 9:30 pm. The specialty of the SHF was staffing a table decorated as a Paris street scene. Desserts and coffee were served and crêpes were made on the spot to order.

North Springs HS (Ga.)

Plusieurs membres de la société sont allés à une Boulangerie Française qui s'appelle la Vie de France, ici à Atlanta. Le directeur nous y a donné une explication, en français, de la fabrication du pain, et nous avons goûté des échantillons.

Nous avons invité le propriétaire de La Rive Gauche, une boutique des vêtements créés par Yves St. Laurent. Il nous a parlé en français de la haute couture française.

Les membres de la Société vont participer dans notre Soirée Française. Cette soirée va consister de plusieurs petites pièces, des contes de fée, des chansons, des fables, et d'autres activités en français. Les membres de la société vont donner des discours sur l'art français et vont montrer quelques-uns de leurs tableaux peints dans les styles différents. Les parents et les amis sont invités à ce programme.

Pekin Community HS (Ill.)

In April, the students planned a Parents' Night where they invited their parents to learn some French. They lead their parents in singing French folk songs. Then, the parents counted off by three's in French to divide into groups to learn French tongue twisters and short dialogs. The members taught their parents the French and prizes were awarded to the best groups. Finally, the girls had prepared French pastries and desserts to serve at the end of the evening.

West Side HS (Ind.)

Our fourth and fifth year club members are proud of their TV Tutorial class. The assistant principal of the elementary school arranged to have an aide bring thirty pupils to our High School once a week for what they called "Activity Period." These pupils were taught greetings, basic dialogs and simple songs and games. They were given French names and they learned to do simple calculations. All lessons were videotaped before presentation. This allowed for the contingency that on a scheduled day the "teachers" might not be able to get an excuse from their regularly scheduled classes. It also meant that they monitored their lessons before teaching the elementary pupils. The real purpose of this project was to stimulate interest in the French language so that when these students go to the Junior High School, where they have a choice of languages, they will select French.

Hollis Area HS (NH)

The day of the induction ceremony has been set aside as Foreign Language Day at the school. During the day, students will wear flags of their respective foreign countries and some will wear native costumes. Foreign language cultural projects made by the students will be on display and samples of French, Spanish, and German pastries will be available. The evening will consist of much the same for parents and friends, as well as the induction ceremony.

Ball High School (Tx.)

SHF Activities included: class projects--students drew pictures of castles; made calendars, puzzles, road signs, posters, mobiles, gave reports on life in France; money-making project--a successful sale of French perfume.

Albemarle HS (Va.)

Members have tutored throughout year on individual basis. Car washes, etc. have been held to give a special award to outstanding French student at graduation ceremonies. We are also in rehearsal for musical scenes from Un Violon sur le Toit, which will be given the night of our SHF initiation (so as to provide entertainment for parents).

Midlothian HS (Va.)

Language Week was our major activity of the year. We worked in conjunction with the Spanish, Latin and French clubs and the Drama department whose production of Man of La Mancha was presented that week. We participated in the Bazaar by selling French perfumes and one member housed one of the foreign exchange students who visited our school during the week.

North Farmington HS (Mi)

The group is presenting a puppet show at a local mall to promote North Farmington Daze. This will run for three days and possibly help to pass an upcoming village vote.

Henry Clay HS (Ky.)

One member, C. Ann Hatfield, was chosen from Fayette county to represent the city of Lexington as an exchange student, with our French sister city, Deauville. Her stay in France began in March and will conclude in July.

West Haven HS (Ct.)

Meetings twice a month, also Christmas dinner and social teas in April with

Notre Dame HS. This was an innovation to join the two chapters and was a complete success! The whole town was happy about the good Public Relations of our two schools! (Bravo to chapter sponsors Emma Blanch and Patricia Marcucci!)

Red Bank Regional HS (NJ)

(Initiation ceremony suggestion) Each inductee will be holding his own small white candle. The president will take a small candle from the table, light it from the mother candle, and then, light the candle of the first inductee to her right while saying: "Pour bien connaître un homme, il faut savoir sa langue." The inductee then responds: "Un homme qui sait deux langues en vaut deux." He then turns to the inductee at his right and gives the cue: "Pour bien..." Finally, the newly appointed members go to the head table, shake hands with the honored guests, receive the kiss of international brotherhood from the advisor as well as his membership card, and return to their seats.

Hillsborough HS (Fla.)

(From Red and Black of April 23, 1975) "Big Spender", "Mame", "Cabaret", "Hello Dolly" and "Good Morning Starshine" were only a few of the songs sung when, on Thursday, March 13, the French Department presented "Evening in Paris."

Some highlights of the show were the two comedy skits performed by Cindy Roskay and Brian Coffin. Included were several poems, one of which Mark Neumaier said to the accompaniment of his 12 string guitar.

The big number came at the end of the show when Monsieur Garcia danced along with 11 chorus girls to a number from "Godspell." During the program awards were presented for outstanding grades in French.
