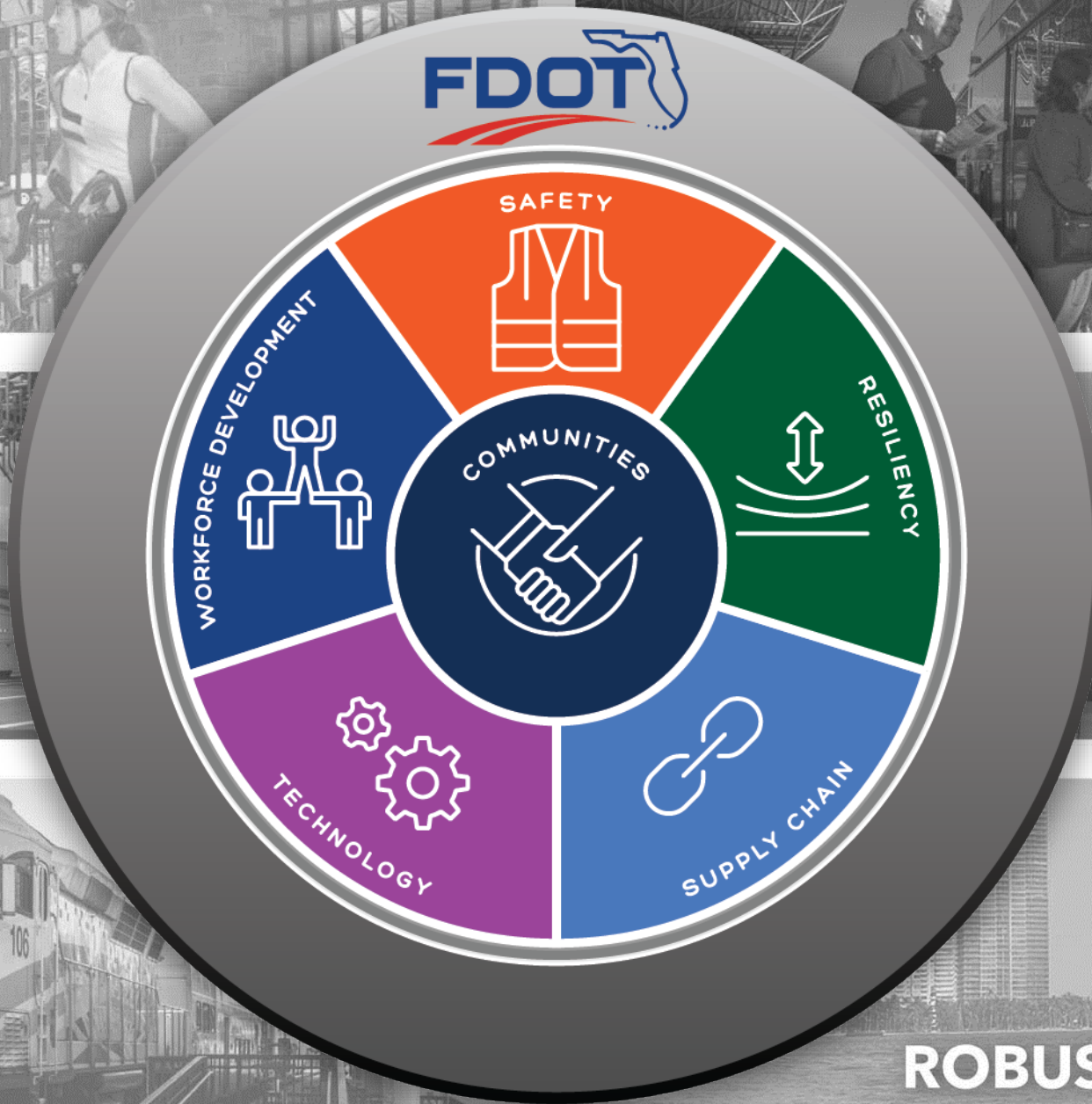

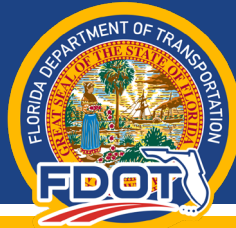

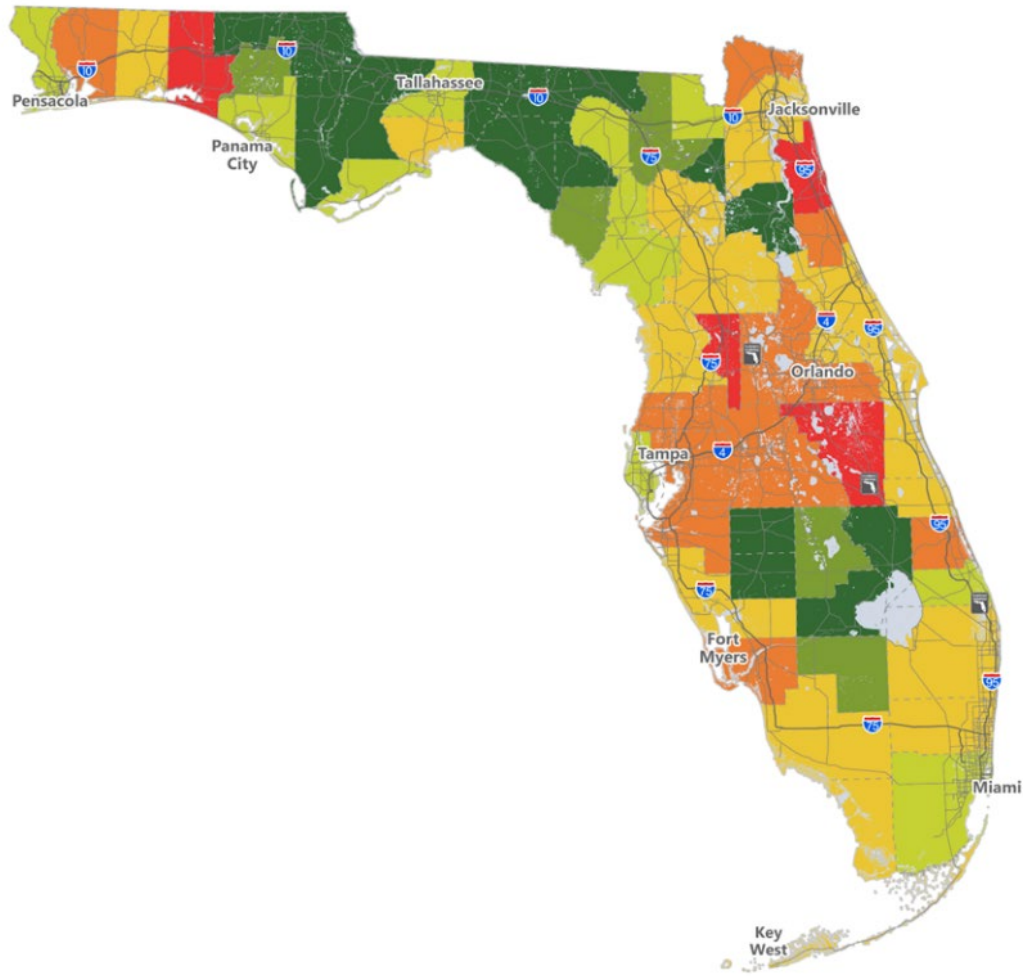

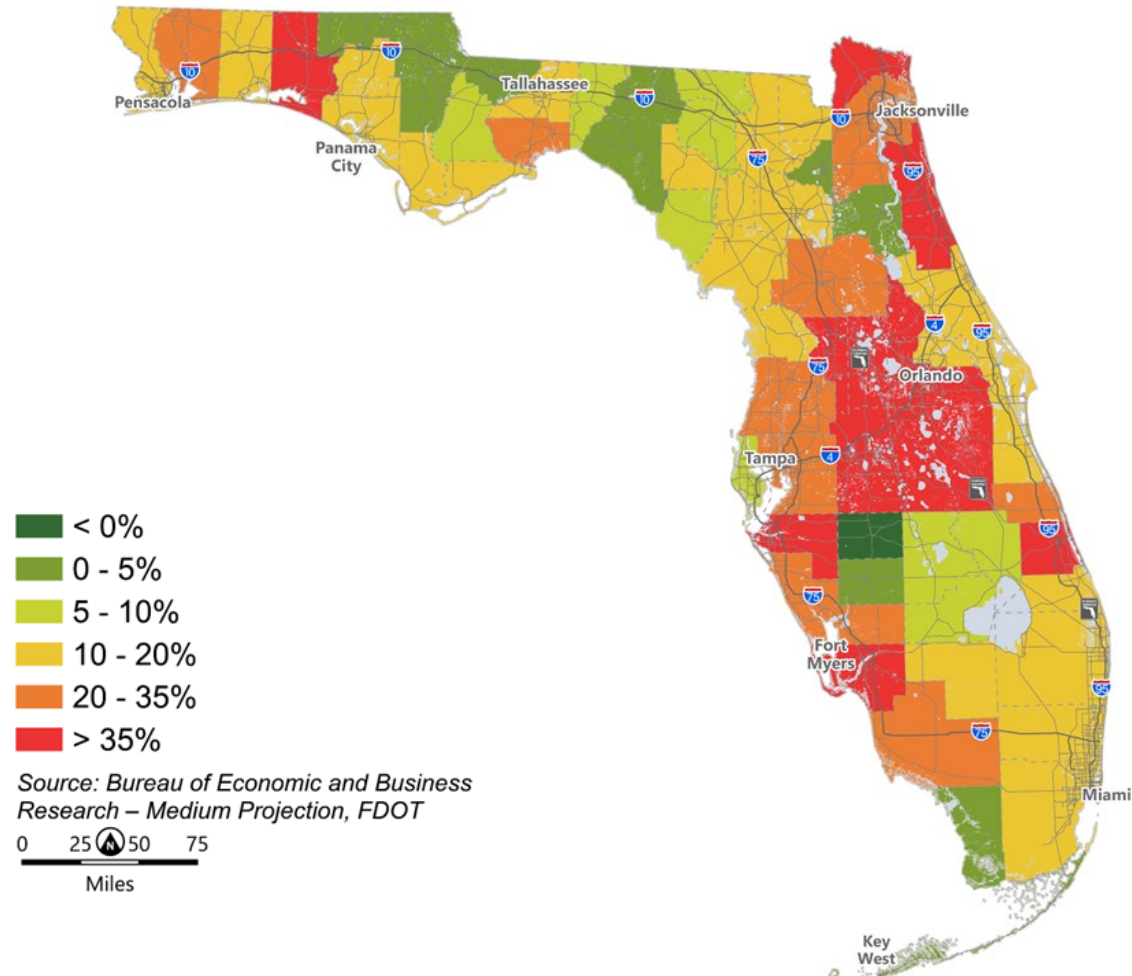
FLORIDA'S POPULATION SURGE



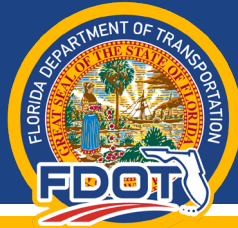
2010-2021 POPULATION GROWTH



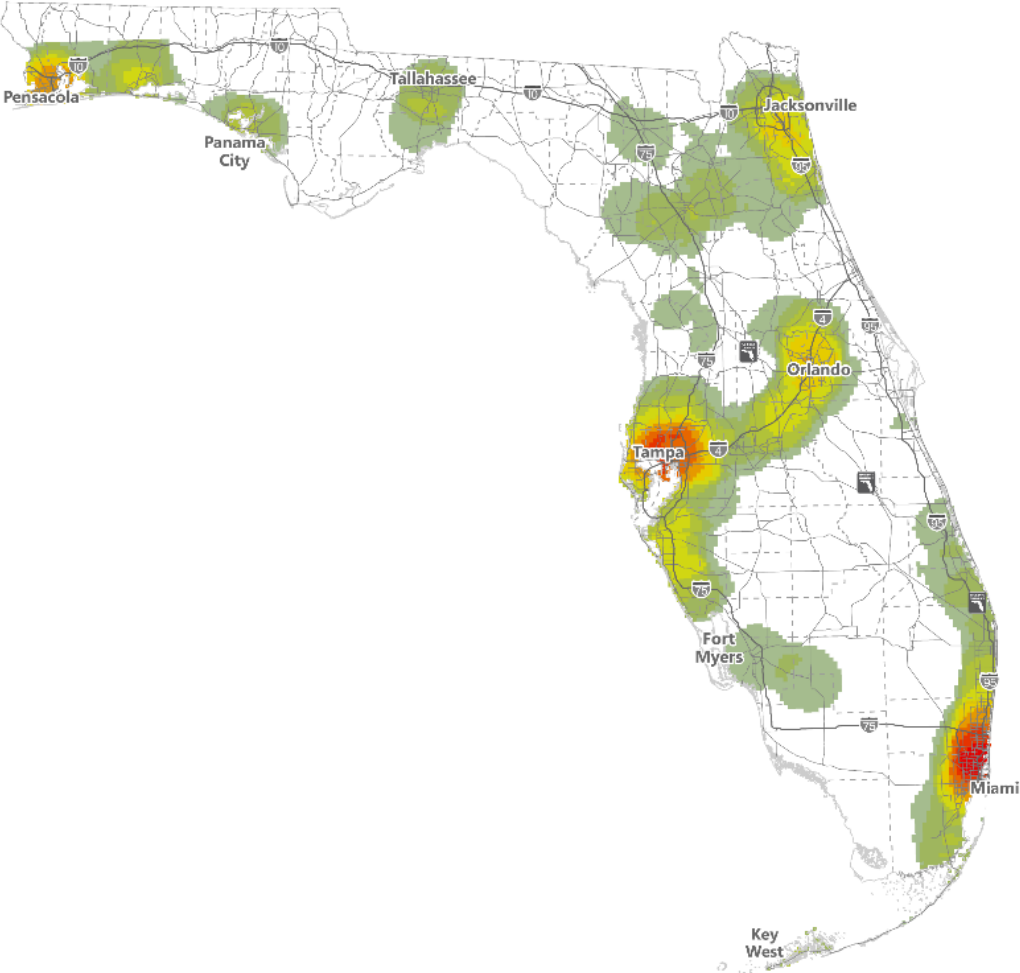
2021-2045 POPULATION PROJECTIONS



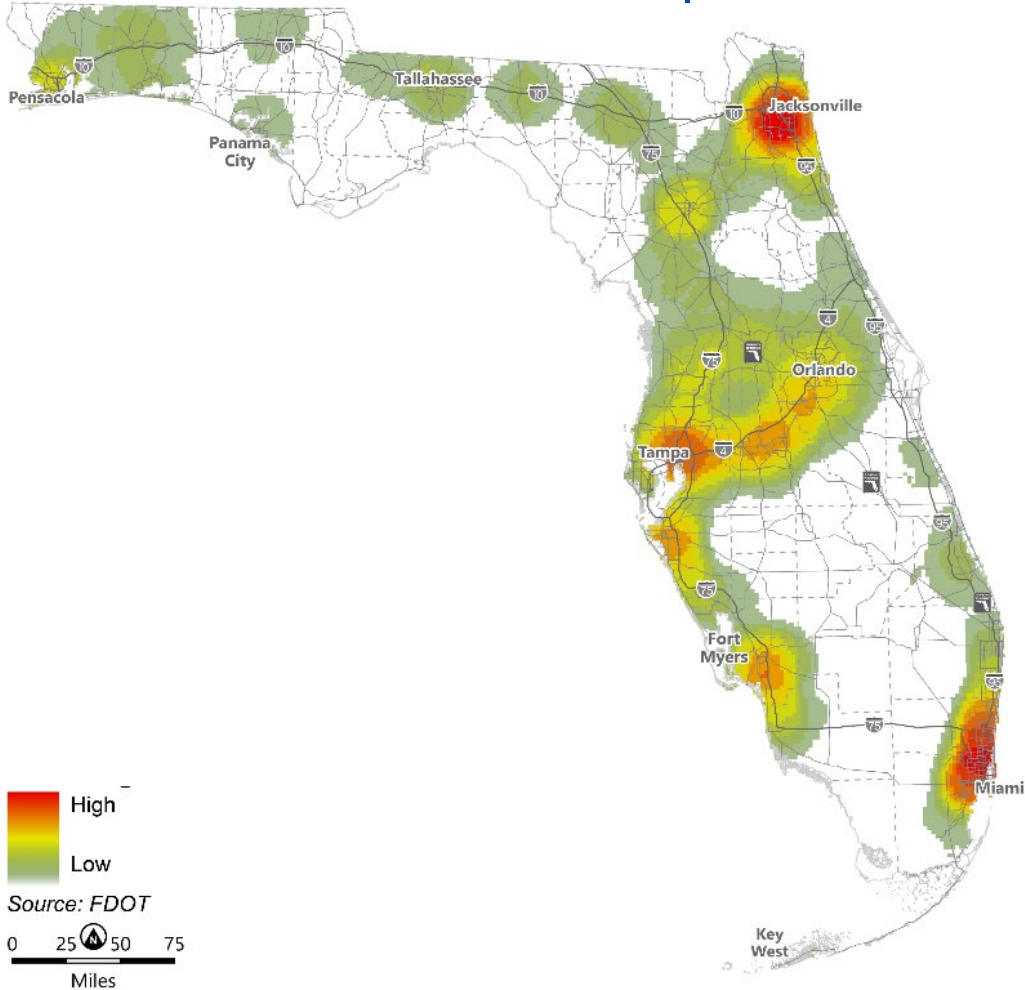

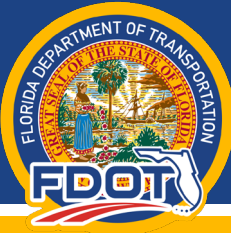
EXISTING CONGESTION | 2021

- **\$156.3 million** – Community Trail Projects

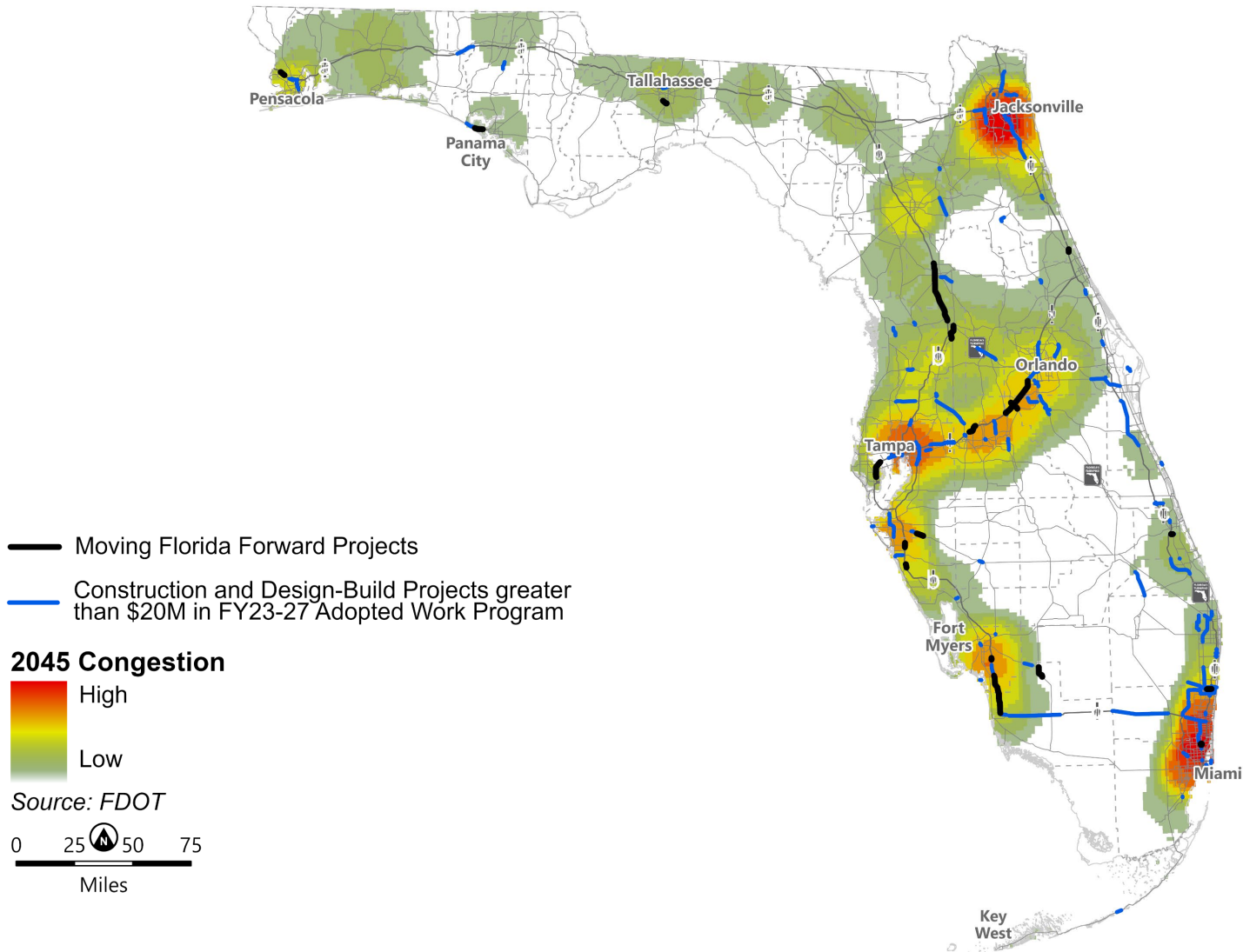
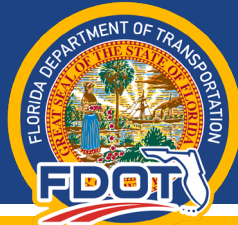

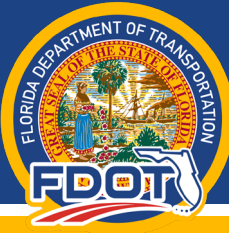
