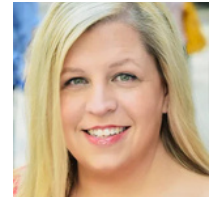

Session 5: Engineering Under Pressure: Crisis Prevention, Preparedness & Communication for Engineering Leaders

About: This is an interactive training designed to make crisis competency a core leadership skill. The session focuses on helping leaders recognize risks earlier, prevent avoidable crises, and create a culture of empowered, prepared teams. Participants will examine the changing risk landscape facing engineering firms, from job site and safety incidents to AI, cyber threats, internal communications, employee conduct, and reputational challenges. Real-world case studies will demonstrate how leadership decisions, communication, and the speed of information can either contain or escalate a crisis. Participants will then work through realistic engineering crisis simulations, making decisions in real time as new information and challenges emerge.
