Legislative Update

STIP

- o Draft STIP released and is available online
- o NCDOT revenue is increasing, but this rate is flatter than the rate of construction cost increases.
- o \$11B in cost increases since 2024-2033 stip was adopted.
- Due to this need to be fiscally constrained, project schedules need to be adjusted, and overall fewer projects programmed in STIP.
- o Some projects in current STIP funded for PE only will no longer be in the updated STIP.
- There will be some additional changes as cost estimates are updated and as planning organizations and Divisions determine if there will be any project swaps.
- Project schedules will be adjusted in May and June, and Project Managers will be determining the actions each project team needs to take to successfully deliver each project.
- o The STIP is scheduled to be finalized and adopted by the Board of Transportation in July.
