5) Anticipated PEF Opportunities

- a) Updates from SMU.
- b) The bridge program is overprogrammed, re-prioritization is underway. There are about 90 projects that are being delayed. Current projects have all been assigned with no anticipated new projects being assigned in the near future.SMU on-call will be extended by 1 year and will re-advertise in 2026. The Structures LSC is anticipated to still include qualifications for the Bridge Program work (full-service) even though the projects will be managed by PMU.
