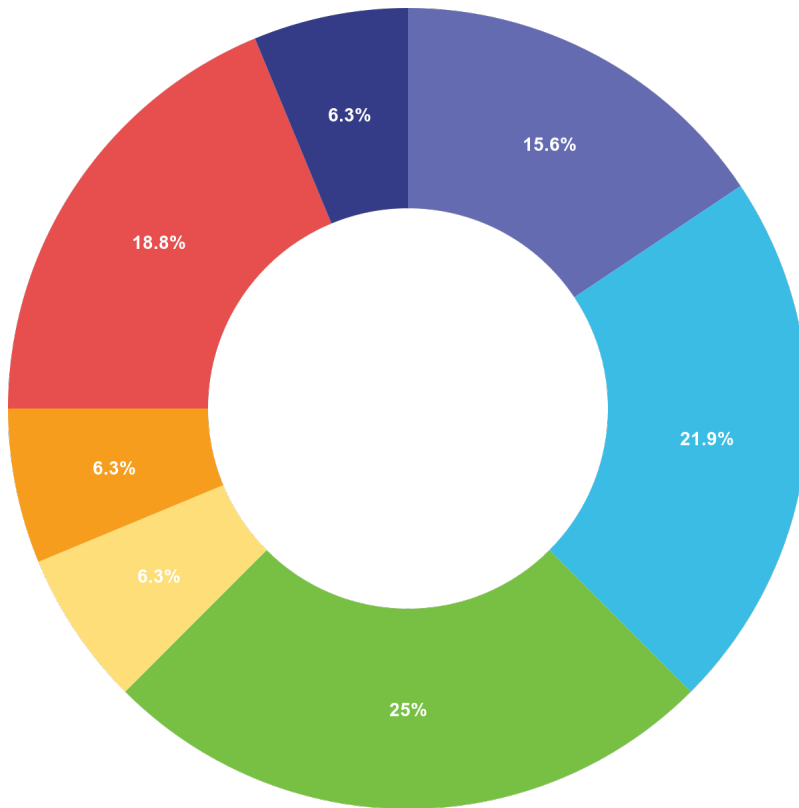
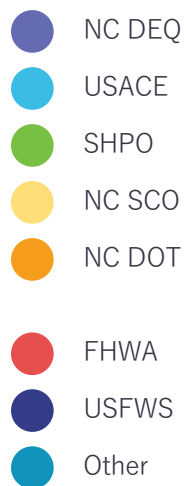
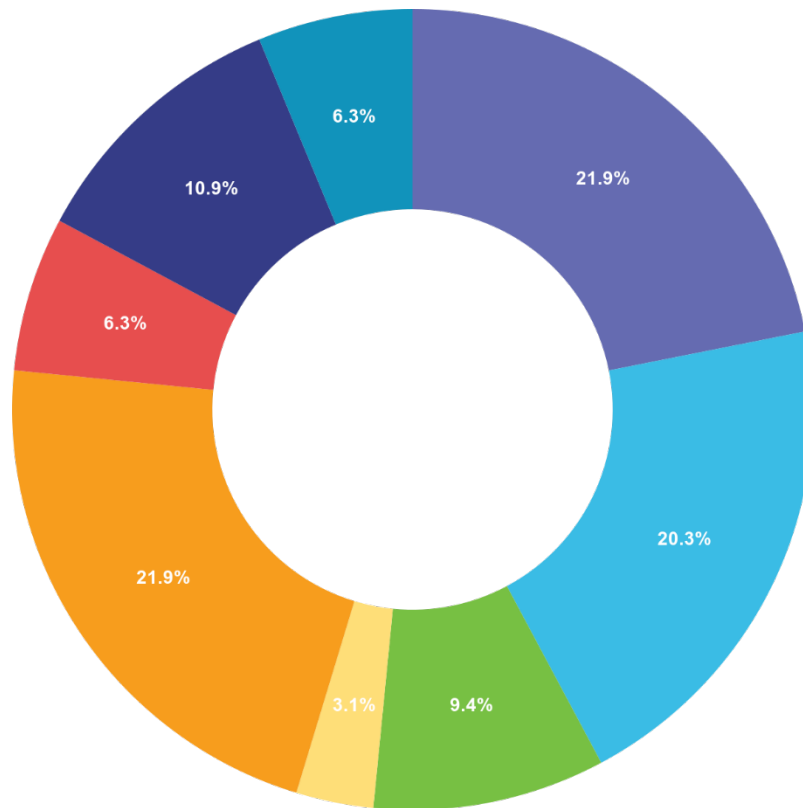


Q1 What is your primary engineering discipline?*

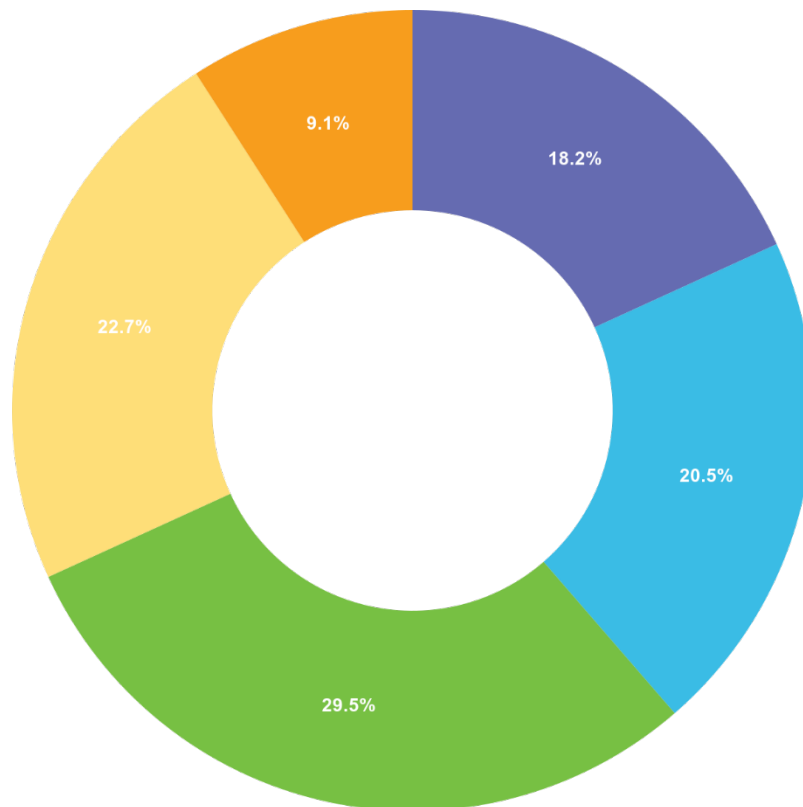
Q2 What regulatory agencies, divisions and/or departments do you interact with most frequently?*
