3) Bridge Design Workshop Series

- a) Review Bridge Design Workshop tracking spreadsheet
 - i) Held the Hurricane Helene Recovery Update on October 15, 2025. Many thanks to Adam, Aaron, and Kristy for a great presentation.
- b) Update current potential topics and add new potential topics
- c) Identify next workshop to schedule
 - i) Next workshop will be Bridge Rehabilitation and Repair in January 2026. Emily will reach out to ACEC for McKimmon Center dates.
 - Ideas include discussion of draft manual, funding sources, common repairs and general practices, virtual field trip
 - ii) Discuss potential candidates for next topics
 - Alligator River Bridge Replacement (Summer 2026)
 Possible topics include project overview, pile operations, large girders.
 - NCDOT Standard Cored Slab, Box Beams, and In-Kind Timber Bridge. These topics could be combined for a workshop or other presentation. NCDOT to consider timing of presenting In-Kind Timber Bridge material as it may be a good topic to address soon.
 - Timber bridge standards not intended for superelvation and not intended to have

- guardrail on bridge.
- Items of interest from cored slab/box beam standard design criteria include a summary of assumptions for items such as distribution factors, prestress losses.

6) Technical Topics

- a) Recent revisions to manuals, standards, etc. New PSP for Cored Slab and Box Beam Post Tensioning Dated 8-25-25 addresses requirements for calibration of equipment and tensioning force.
- b) Upcoming revisions to manuals, standards, etc. Integral end-bent design manual revision is still pending.
- c) Digital Delivery, OBD/Open X, and ProjectWise implementation there will be a new workspace implemented when NCDOT switches to the next version of Open X. The update will implement line styles and eliminate roles. Per the October 2023 memo from the Chiefs office, firms should be placing deliverables on the NCDOT PW server. Some firms are doing project work on NCDOT PW.
