Pennsylvania's aging populations, children, food delivery, and employees of thousands of businesses depend on these transportation networks and without adequate funding, delays, closures, and service lines could be critically impacted.

While HB 1364 will address significant, identified needs for Pennsylvania's 67-county transit network, it also provides relief for aging roads and bridges.
