Elisabeth Klawunn is currently the Manager of Construction and Maintenance at the Delaware River Port Authority. In this role she oversees the DRPA's capital construction program. A Professional Engineer licensed in the state of New Jersey, Ms. Klawunn has over sixteen years of civil and structural engineering experience and has been a dedicated public servant for over fifteen years.

At the DRPA, Ms. Klawunn also serves as the Bridge Engineer for the Benjamin Franklin Bridge. Some notable construction projects she has managed include the \$195 million Contract No. BF-54-2019, the Benjamin Franklin Bridge Rehabilitation of Suspension Spans and Anchorages project and Contract No. 12-I, the \$31.5 million Installing Elevators in Remaining Stations project, the completion of which made PATCO a fully accessible transit line.

Ms. Klawunn holds a B.S. in Architectural Engineering from Drexel University, and she is currently working on her dual Master of Science in Interdisciplinary Engineering from Purdue University & Master of Business Administration from Indiana University's Kelley School of Business. She is an active member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, the Structural Engineering Institute, and, as a member of WTS International, a mentor in their Transportation YOU program, which introduces women between the ages of 13 and 18 to a variety of transportation careers.
