

Dr. Kenneth R. White: Dr. White is a Regents Professor Emeritus in Civil Engineering at New Mexico State University. He has been a professor, Department Head, Associate Dean of Research and Interim Dean. He was the technical lead for a multi-disciplinary, multi-institution research team in “Testing the I-40 Bridges Across the Rio Grande, and “Testing the Dang San Bridge” in Seoul, Korea.” Dr. White served 9 years on the New Mexico State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors. He is Past President of the New Mexico Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers. Among his awards, Dr. White received the “Leadership in Transportation and Development” award from the NM DOT Research Bureau, November 2000, the Distinguished Service Award twice from the National Council of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Surveyors, 1999 and 2005, “Ingeniero Veterano De Nuevo Mejico” from the New Mexico Society of Professional Engineers, 1998, and the “Transportation Award for Excellence in Research” Alliance for Transportation Research, 1994. He served 8 years as the State Transportation Commissioner for Southwestern New Mexico (District 1). In 2022, he was given the Aggie Legend Award.

Dr. White has been a lead instructor for “Bridge Inspection Training” for over thirty different state DOTs and is the lead author for two editions of the text, *Bridge Maintenance Inspection and Evaluation*. He was invited as the keynote speaker to the “International Conference on Bridge Inspection and Management” in Beijing, China, October 2004. He was the Principal Investigator on Bridge Testing and Evaluation (for the FHWA) and Bridge Inspection and Evaluation (NMDOT) for over twenty years.
