Rich has served as the District Executive for PennDOT's Engineering District 4 since January 2019. As District Executive, Rich has oversight of a 6-County area in northeast PA and is involved in the Design, Construction, Maintenance and Operations of 4,000 miles of roads and 2,100 bridges, with an annual budget of over \$400 million.

Prior to coming to District 4, Rich was the Director of the Bureau of Maintenance and Operations for 5 years.

Prior to joining the Bureau, Rich worked in Engineering District 8-Harrisburg for 16 years. He served as the ADE for Maintenance; Design Services Engineer; and several other engineering capacities, starting in 1998.

Rich is a graduate of Penn State, obtaining a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering and a minor in Environmental Engineering; along with a Master of Public Administration Degree.
