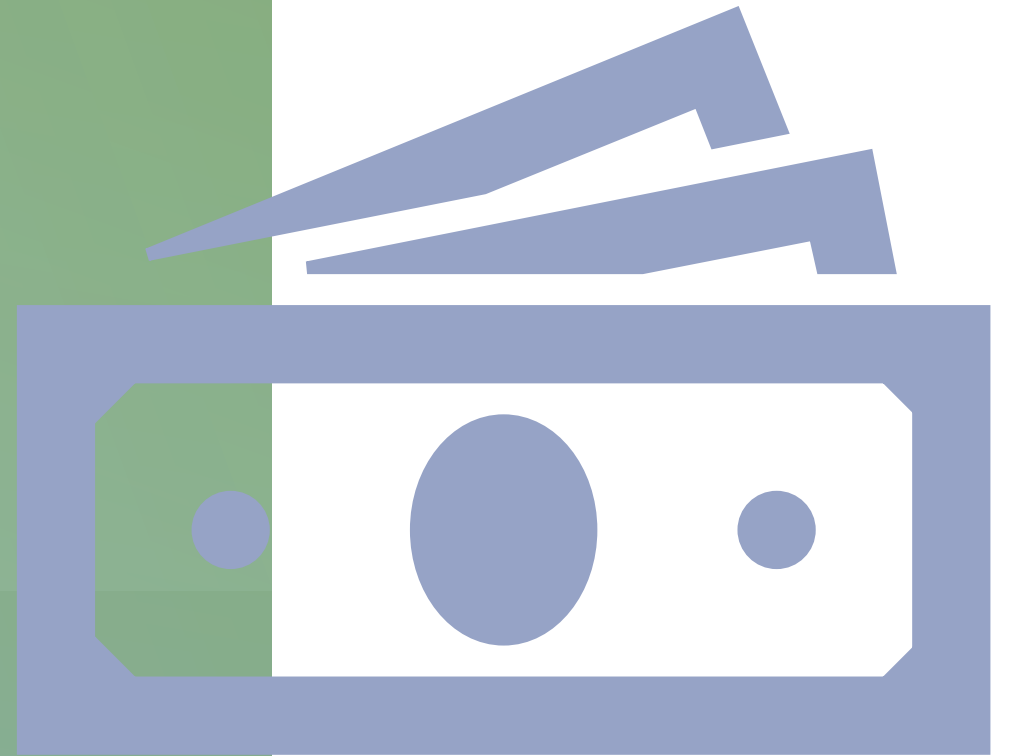

IS A PAC WORTH THE TROUBLE?

Amplified, Unified Voice

Pooling resources enables an organization to make a larger impact than by individual donations alone.

Enhances Advocacy & Education

Provides an opportunity to support existing or future advocacy or business strategies and goals by building relationships over time and educating policymakers by you as industry experts.

Strategic Influence

PACs are another tool to gain face-to-face time with policymakers to educate and ensure you are the “first call” for an elected official or prospective candidate.
