


# CONSTRUCTION ISSUES

- Contract Time – no work
- Ride Quality
- Low Inlets – Torts
- Water issues - Ponding
- Shoulder Cross Slopes – Icing
- Slippery Pavement
- Rock Cap/Undercut/Drainage



# CONSTRUCTABILITY

- Drainage/MPT conflicts with phasing
  - Pipe invert elevations
  - Inlet elevations vs. temp. roadway elevations
  - Phase transitions
  - Drop-off conditions
- Lack of utility and inlet risers
- Utility conflicts

# DIGITAL DELIVERY

## Route 68 – Dolby Street to Trout Run

### **District 10 Lets Project with Digital Model, Incorporating ProjectWise 365 and Infrastructure Cloud Reviews**

In September 2024, District 10-0 let the PA 68 Dolby Street to Trout Run Model as the Legal Document (MALD) pilot project, utilizing Bentley's ProjectWise 365 and Infrastructure Cloud for 90% constructability and PS&E reviews, respectively, in the design process. Amanda Olbeter, District highway design manager, explained that the realignment and bridge replacement project will improve safety and access along a 4,000-foot corridor on SR 68 in Monroe and Clarion Townships. Enhancements include: 48 driveway and associated ADA curb ramp facilities, sidewalks to enhance multimodal connectivity, new drainage features, and widening and variable-depth overlay to increase structural pavement depth and adjust superelevation and cross slope.



# GATEWAY 228 CORRIDOR

- Balls Bend and Haines School to Freedom Road projects (shown in Magenta) – LET 1/07/21
  - under construction and will be 2 lanes in each direction.
  - Received BULID Grant Award #1 (\$20M) : Total Bid = \$36.5M (approx. 2.35 miles)
- Three Degree Road and Freedom Road projects (Shown in Cyan) – LET 10/20/22
  - projects will result in 2 lanes in each direction.
  - Received BUILD Grant Award #2 (\$25M) : Total Bid = \$74.4M (approx. 4.38 miles)
- SR228 Mars RR Bridge West Expansion (shown in Yellow) - Final Section
  - Project Length approx. 3.5 mile long
  - Two-lane section of Route 228 with a current ADT of 29,795 - significant commercial and residential development
  - Project Status: in the late stages of Preliminary Engineering
  - Construction (not funded)



# DISTRICT SELECTION COMMITTEE

- Project Manager is the Committee Chairperson
- Committee varies by project and scope
- General Requirements are verified first
  - Disqualification Letter will be sent after selection
- Scored based on each Advertised Selection Criteria
- Every consultant has an opportunity even if preliminary engineering was performed by another firm.
