- Is it the same for everyone?



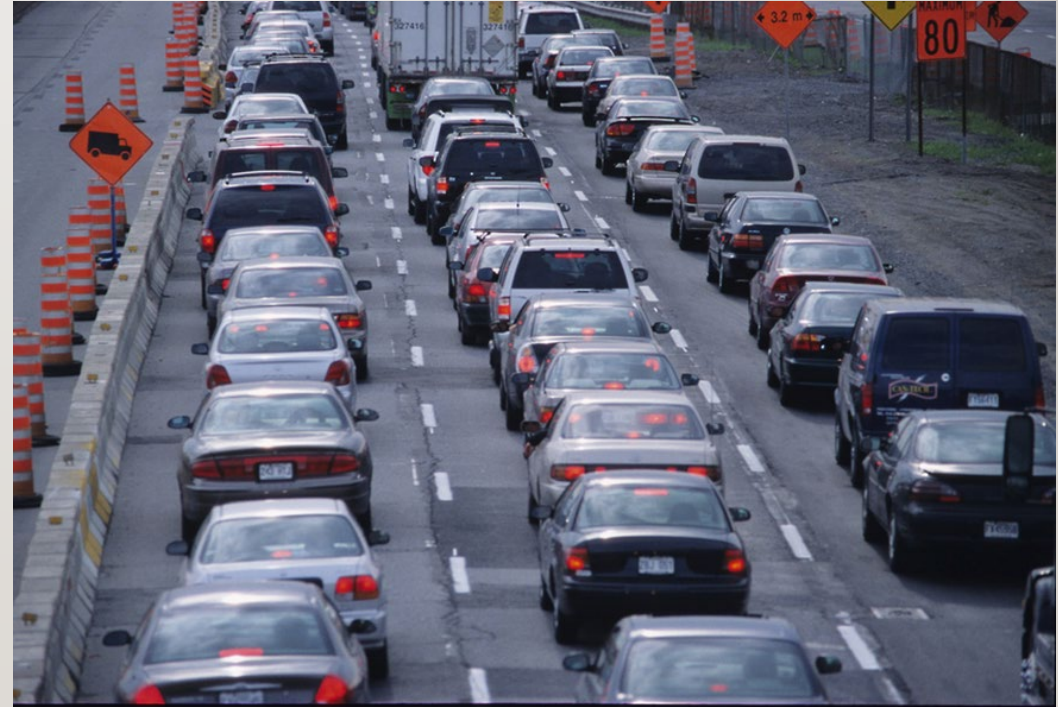
RISK AND REWARD

- What steps, or controls, do we use to decrease this risk?





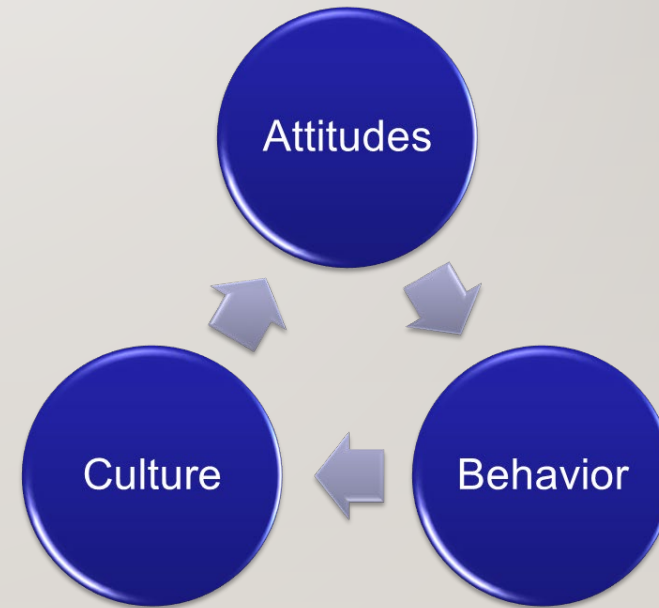
INTERNAL RESPONSIBILITY SYSTEM

HOW IS A SAFETY CULTURE FORMED?

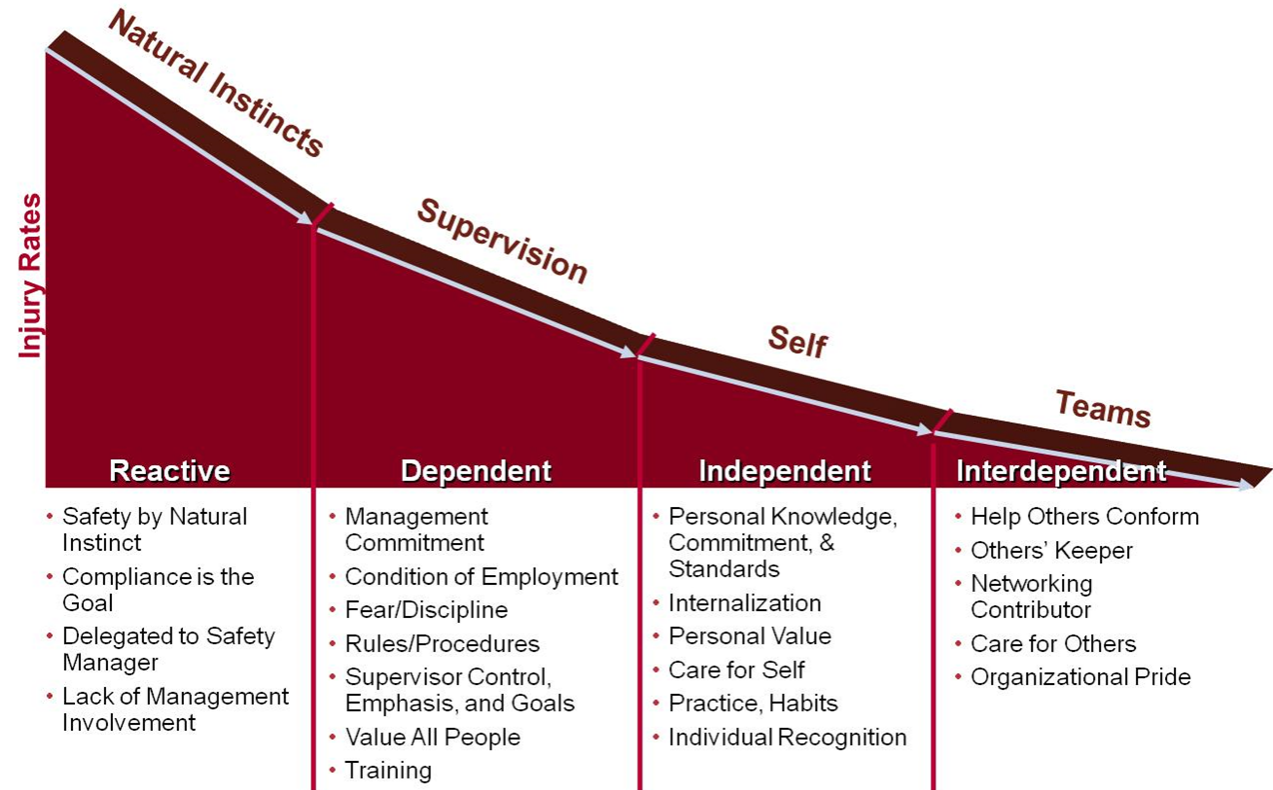
- Policy dictates safety but people need to choose to follow them or not?

- The level of acceptance directly impacts the appearance of what is acceptable behavior.



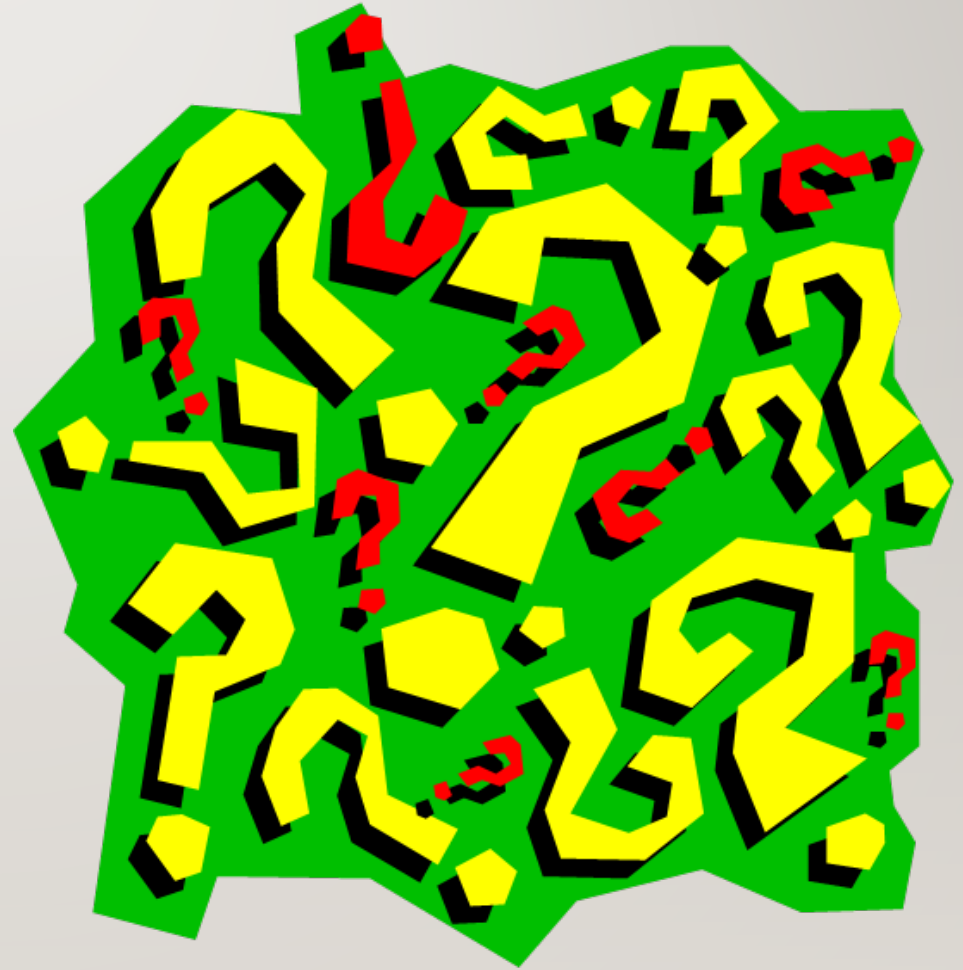
