**Call to Order:** ACEC-SC Chair Cameron Nations called the meeting to order at 1:55pm with roll call. In attendance were: Keith Overstreet, Jason Eppley, Chuck Black, Petrina Butler, Jeff Mulliken, Kevin Shoemake, Kylie Page, Rick Fauteau, Emily Swearingen, Committee Chair, Joe Jones, Adam Jones and Elaine Mikell. Also in attendance were Anna Lucas and Daniel Sabia, POND (new members). Those not in attendance were: Matt Gehman, Mike Wooten, Jerry Carter.

**Consent Agenda-** motion made to approve, seconded and passed.

- Annual Meeting/Board Meeting minutes with changes from Jason Eppley.
- Abbreviated membership report to be changed to full membership report for next meeting.

**Financial Report-** motion made to approve with the following changes/additions. Seconded and passed.

- Secretary/Treasurer Eppley said that the budget will be in next financial report.
- Monthly income \$69,959.81, expenses \$19,996.06, net income \$49,963.75.
- Projected expenses to be added to this budget.

**Chair's Report (Cameron Nations):**

- 2017-2018 ACEC-SC Executive Director Performance Review.
  - Goal #1 Administrative Readiness.
  - Goal #2 Strengthen the ACEC Name with Politicians.
  - Goals #3 Work with Board of Directors to accomplish goals of the Strategic Plan to bring purpose and value to member firms.
  - Goal #4 Work with Board to meeting PAC Goals.
  - Goal #5 Assist Board with staying on budget.
- Motion was made to continue the performance review on a yearly basis, seconded and passed.
- Participation of this will be: Current Board members and executive committee.
- Collective review by sitting board and review will be brought forward by Executive Committee.
- Board Meeting attendance is critical. By-laws state if three consecutive board meetings are missed, the seat is considered vacant. There will be a call-in number for future Board meetings.

**Executive Directors Report (Adam Jones):**

**Legislative Report**

- Budget Provisos.
  - Pipe Bill did not pass this session but will return in 2019.
  - DOT/Utility Relocation-this provides SCDOT to use federal aid road and bridge program funds for relocation of public water and sewer utility. Overstreet said the Utility Water Council needs to carry the involvement, but we should remain involved.
  - Bills dealing with Base Load Review Act and VC Summer Nuclear fallout passed out of conference.

- Off season lobbying will begin when Adam Jones returns from surgery.
  - First group of meetings will be with legislators who are running unopposed.
  - Second group of meetings will be with those who have received PAC monies.
  - Third group of meetings will be with the newly elected legislators.
    - They will discuss bills that are expected to come up and Qualifications Based Selection.
- SCESS nominated Alan Campbell, Applied Building Sciences, Inc., to be engineering representative on the Building Code Council. He was appointed by Governor in mid-July.
- Consent Agendas, Board Meeting Minutes & Board Agendas.
  - Will be emailed every Thursday before Board Meetings – to include agenda, minutes, membership report, membership application, and financial report-should all be reviewed prior to meeting.
  - Wednesday before Board Meeting-Full Board Packet (Same information as the day of the Board Meeting, this will be everything that will be discussed at the Board Meeting).
- Motion made for the Board Meeting Minutes to be submitted in Bullet format. Seconded and passed.
- The Leadership of North Carolina and Georgia has proposed a leadership meeting in Greenville, SC.
  - Dinner on Thursday evening and meetings on Friday. North Carolina is spearheading.
  - Some thought this was a good idea, some did not.
  - View this as an opportunity to share ideas.
  - Jones will proceed with this.
- Gubernatorial Debate-join forces with other associations to host a “soapbox” type event between the two gubernatorial candidates. There would be minimal costs and the cost would be split by a number of groups. Motion made to partner on this event, seconded and passed.
- Golf tournament has to be rescheduled due to the SCDOT golf tournament. Will get date out ASAP.
- 2018 SC Engineering Conference and Trade Show – Commission check is still forthcoming. There were 425 people in attendance. PENC has asked us to consider moving the 2020 to Charlotte, NC.
- ACEC Leadership National Training program-Few dates remaining in November. ACEC covers all the expenses. Program is dinner and half day meeting.
- Adam Jones out on August 13. He will be out of contact until he ends his pain medicines.

#### **ACEC National/National Directors Report (Rick Fauteux):**

- Linda Bauer Darr is the new ACEC President and CEO
  - Begins this job August 6.
  - Plans to visit all the MO's on a regional basis.
  - Rick Fauteux will attend the National convention, October 28-31 in Las Vegas.
- Planning cabinet meeting-Goal is to review ACEC goals, strategic plan, reconvene in fall. Melvin Williams, Peter Strub, and Rick Fauteux are on this national committee.
- National PAC is at \$600,972.00.
- Melvin Williams is also serving on an ACEC subcommittee dealing with diversity within firms and discipline.

- Many engineering companies are target for membership.
- **Grow the Brand (Kylie Page/Keith Overstreet):**
  - Form Ad Hoc Committee.
    - Discuss By-Laws and transparency and how Board members are nominated and process for electing new board members.
    - Have printed copies of by-laws.
    - Have by-laws published on the website and the App.
    - Committee consists of Rick Fauteux, Kylie Page and Cameron Nations but would like more involvement.
    - To make changes to the by-laws, it should be presented to the membership prior to the annual membership meeting.
    - By-laws to be published so membership know they have an opportunity to make Board member nominations.
  - Communication Plan is still in the draft form.  
This is an opportunity to improve the visual presence of ACEC-SC and determine what we want the audience to know.
    - Overstreet to reach out to ACEC national. Communication starts with website.
    - Ricky Ward is now the Communication Committee chair.
    - Revamp website.
      - Address content and layout design-Jones to get proposals for this.
      - Mission statement and Bylaws should be on website
      - Get several examples from other states.
      - ACEC should own the website.
      - Add 2-3 more to the committee.
      - Rick Fauteux will forward the name of someone in his office.
- **Legislative Influence (Adam Jones/Matt Gehman):**
  - Fundraising efforts such as oyster roast.
  - Timeframe may be the Thursday before Board Retreat in March, 2019.
- **Energize and Engage Membership (Adam Jones):**

Notes from meeting:

First item needing attention is the website since it supports so much of ACEC-SC's efforts, and will be essential in successfully implementing the strategic plan

- Decided to take a two-staged approach
  - Near term effort to address current website – enhancements to design, functionality, content, and processes
  - Longer term effort that could potentially align with ACEC national and any strategic changes they may be making under their new CEO
- Need to adopt/develop style guide and branding standards to guide website effort and all communications
- Some content items will require ACEC-SC board discussion/approval, e.g., job board, staffing announcements
- Initial budget for website enhancements is \$5k. Major overhaul could require significantly more resources
- Once we get a plan developed for the website, then start work on other communication elements
