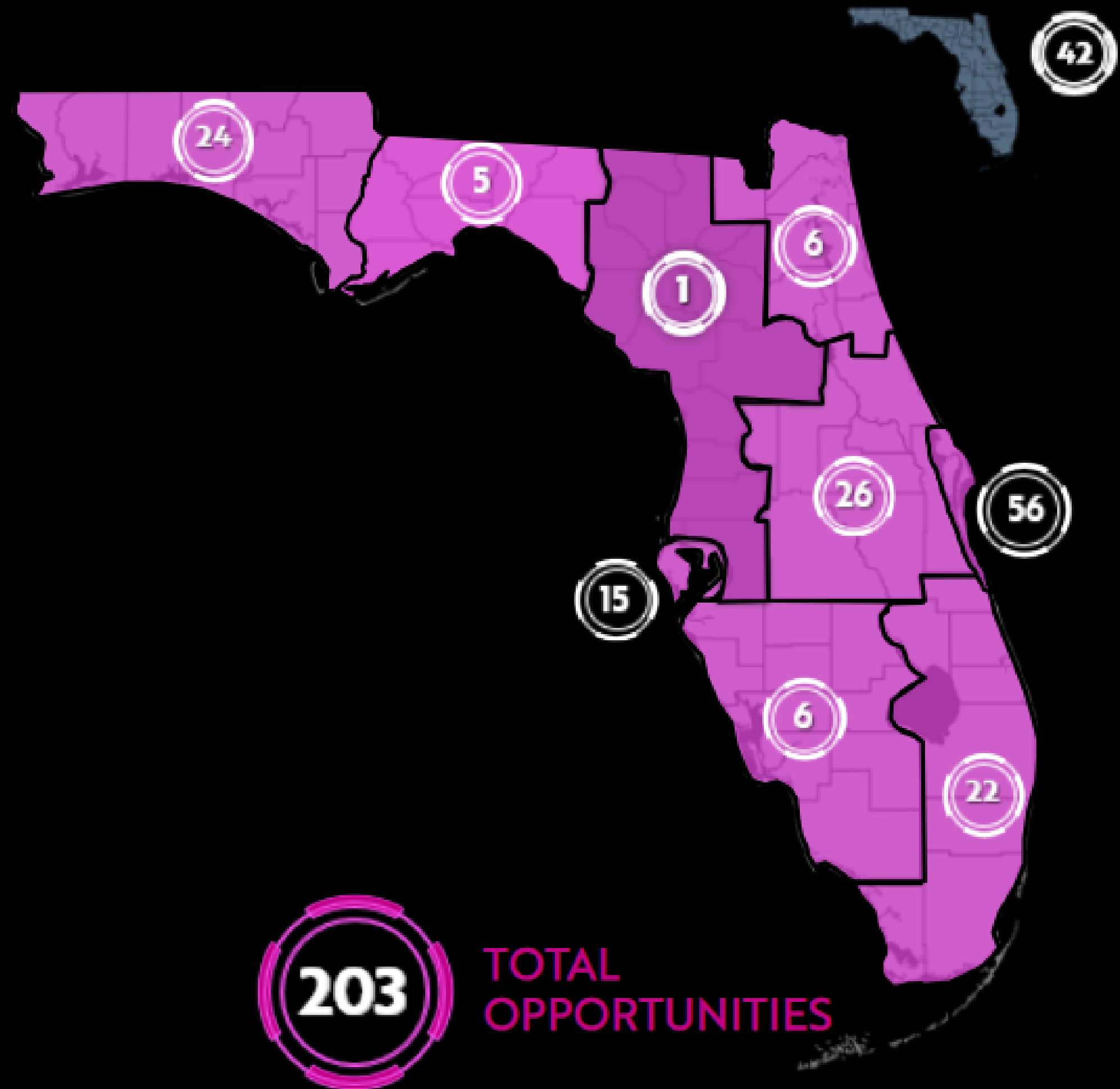

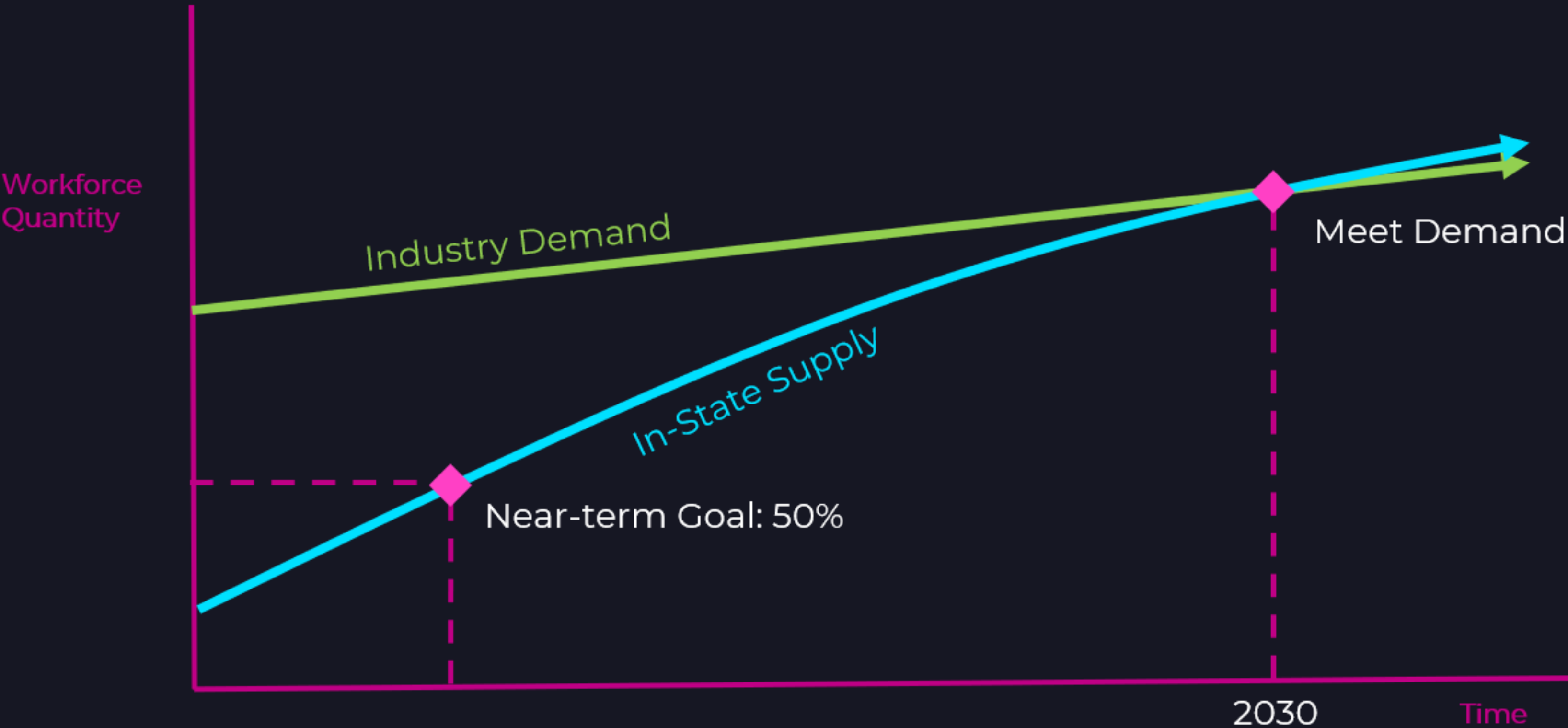

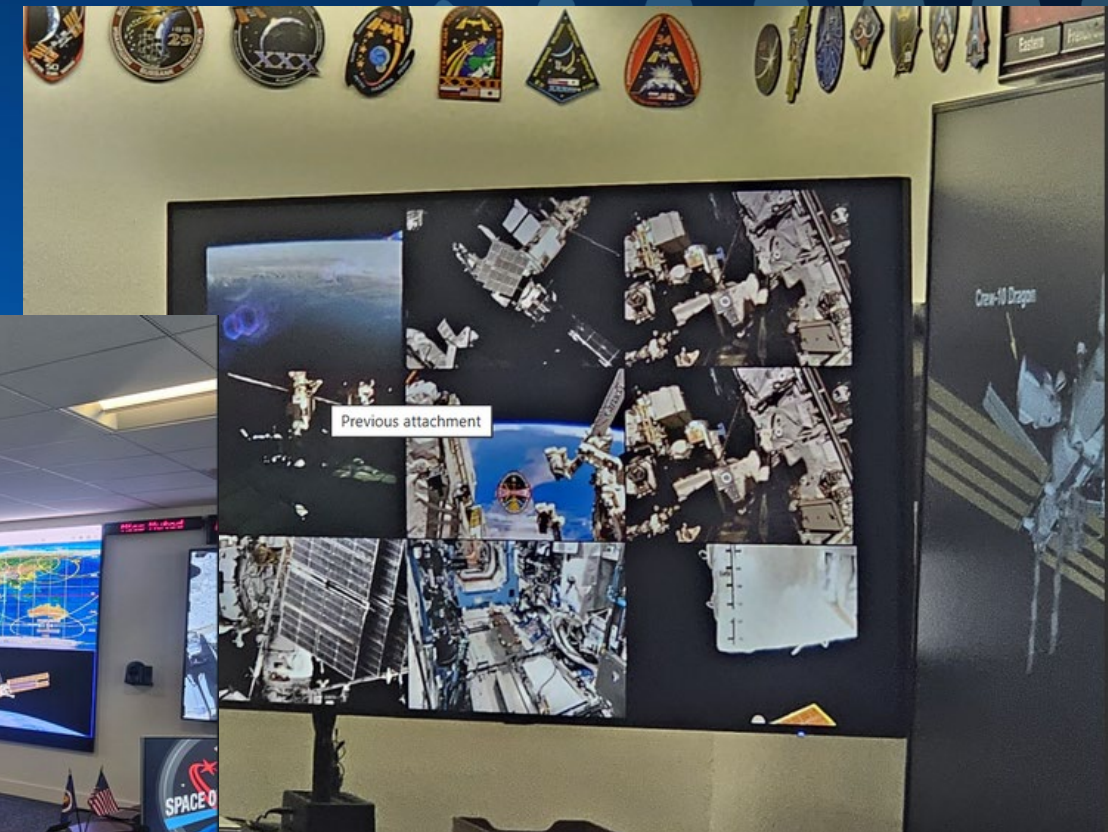

NASA Employment Impact by State



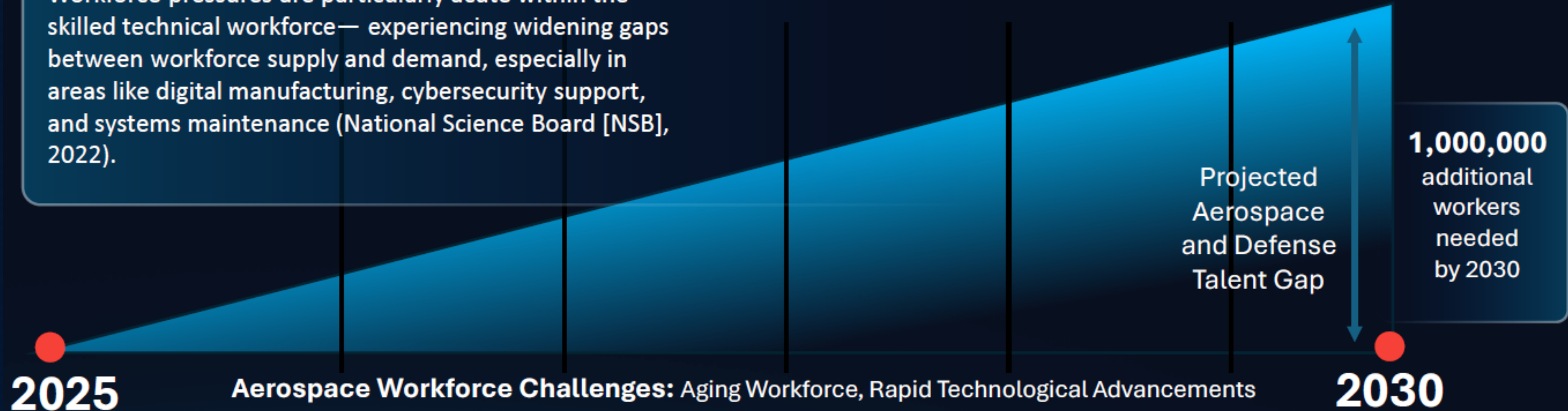

Aerospace and Defense Industry Workforce Shortfall

Problem:

Workforce pressures are particularly acute within the skilled technical workforce—experiencing widening gaps between workforce supply and demand, especially in areas like digital manufacturing, cybersecurity support, and systems maintenance (National Science Board [NSB], 2022).



Solution:

Addressing this gap between supply and demand for technical talent requires **coordinated expansion** of training pathways that **align educational outcomes** with the **key skills** essential to maintaining America's aerospace and defense capabilities.

Goal:

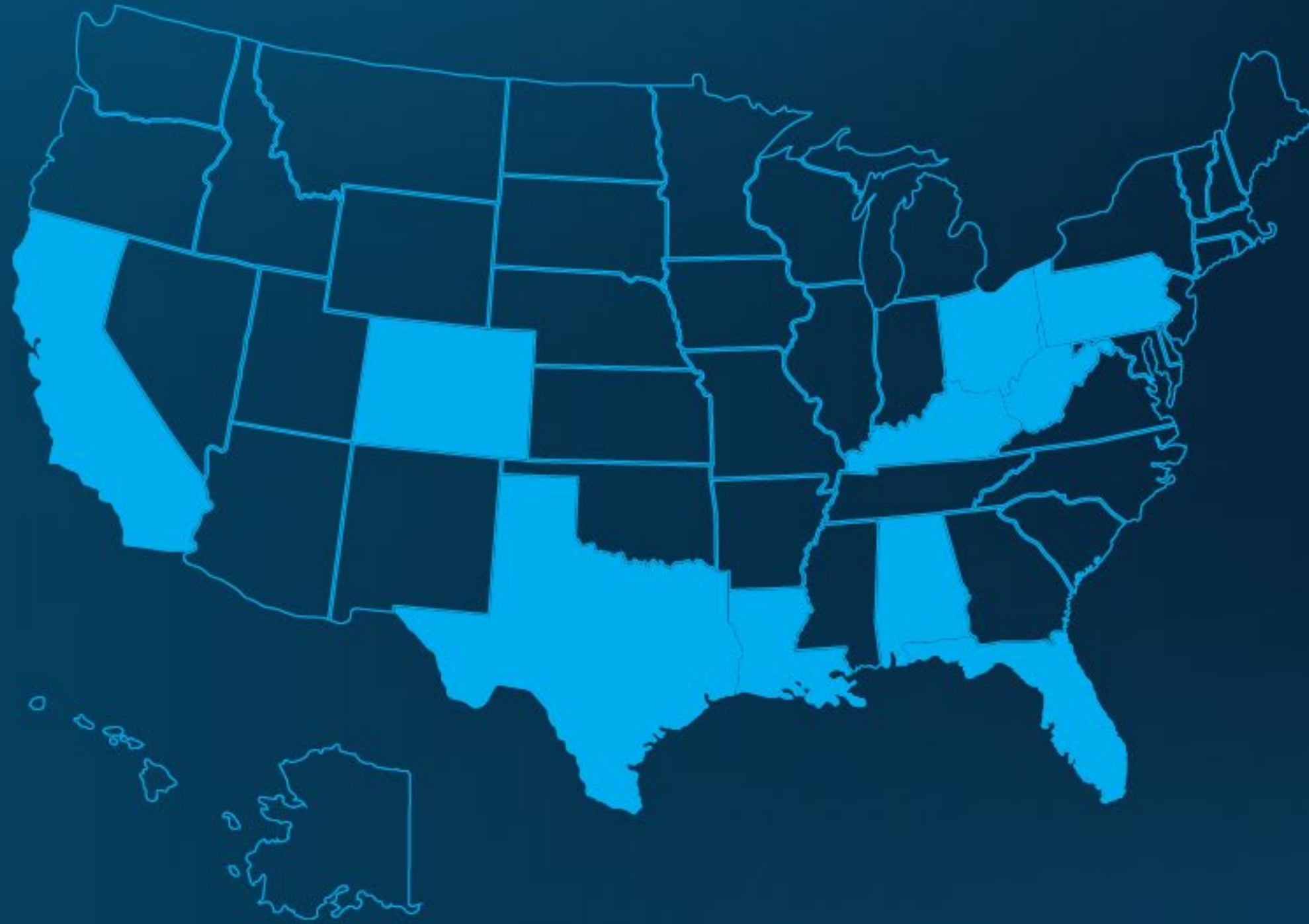
To increase and accelerate the number of students entering the aerospace industry's **skilled technical workforce** that will enable and advance NASA's critical missions.
