Mike Clementi joined Icebreaker in October 2024. Previously, he served as a Professional Staff Member on the Senate Committee on Appropriations Subcommittee on Defense. In his Senate career, Mike worked for both political parties in the majority, including under Full Committee Chairman Thad Cochran, Chairman Richard Shelby, Chairman Patrick Leahy, and Chair Patty Murray. In that capacity, Mike, at some point, had lead oversight responsibilities for the vast majority of appropriations in the defense bill including the Research and Development accounts of the Army, Navy, and Space Force, as well as service procurement accounts, including weapons,

ammunition, munitions, ground combat systems, and aviation systems. His duties also included oversight of intelligence agencies, the Special Operations Command and special access programs across the department. Prior to joining the Committee, Mike was a Navy civilian working as a financial management and budget analyst at the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Financial Management and Comptroller) Office of Budget. In total, he has 17 years of appropriations, defense financial management, budget and program analysis experience.

Mike completed his undergraduate degree at the University of Maryland Baltimore county, receiving a Bachelors of Science in Financial Economics. Mike grew up near Naval Air Systems Command in Southern Maryland and now lives in Arnold, Maryland.
