## COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM NOTE: DEADLINE IS JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of Arkansas and enrolled (or enrolling) in a course of study leading to an undergraduate degree in a construction related field such as, construction management, civil, mechanical, and structural or electrical engineering.
- 2. Applicant must desire a career in a construction related field, construction management, civil, mechanical, structural or electrical engineering.
- 3. Applicant must be enrolled (or enrolling) as a full-time student. Part-time students are not eligible for awards.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Applicants are responsible for insuring that all items listed below are submitted to the Foundation and postmarked no later than JUNE 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - a. Completed Application Forms
  - b. Official Grade Transcript (3 most recent quarters/semesters)
  - c. Resume, if available
  - d. Evaluation/Letter of Recommendation completed by your Academic Advisor
  - e. Any additional information appropriate for consideration

#### **AWARDS**

- 1. Scholarships are not automatically renewed, but the student will be considered for subsequent awards it they provided evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction and continued enrollment and standing in a college program leading to an undergraduate degree in construction, construction management, civil mechanical, structural or electrical engineering.
- 2. Application will be reviewed and winners selected by the Awards Committee of the AGC Scholarship Foundation, which will consider each applicants interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, evaluations and financial need.
- 3. All applicants selected as semi-finalists will be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the AGC Scholarship Foundation. Such representatives will either be a member of the Awards Committee, Trustee, or other person that may be appointed by a majority vote of the members of the committee. All semi-finalists will be notified of their status after evaluations are complete, usually late June.
- 4. Checks will be sent directly to the student in August proceeding the school year upon presentation of enrollment information for the next school term and other information as designated by the Foundation.
