BUILD OUT RULES & REGULATIONS

- Structures cannot be built in advance, they must be built on site at THRIVE Peninsula, 12749 Nettles Drive Newport News, VA 23606 on October 22, 2025 between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Judging and awards will take place after 6:00 p.m.
- Event will take place outdoors, weather backup will be inside the building.
- Approximate size for build out is a parking spot, 16ft L x 8ft W x 10ft H.
- Teams are responsible for transporting canned goods to the event location and must submit their number of canned goods at check-in.
- No limits to team composition. This includes the make up and number of team members. Teams do not need to be AGCVA members, anyone from the community is invited to participate.
- Structures MUST be structurally self-supporting. Permissible: one-quarter inch thick foam-core, cardboard, masonite, plywood, plexiglass – for the purpose of leveling or balancing materials but not as load bearing.
- Upon conclusion of event, all teams will assist with the load in of canned foods that will be donated to The Market at THRIVE.
