#### **AGCVA Member Categories**

- **Contractors:** organizations for which at least 50% of revenue is generated from construction work as a contractor (whether for a fixed price, commission, fee, or percentage).
  - Includes: General Contractors (92) and Subcontractors (170)
  - Must be registered with the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation, Virginia Board for Contractors
- Associates (Service Providers/Suppliers): organizations that are actively engaged in a business related to or affiliated with the construction industry
  - Includes: construction-related manufacturers, construction machinery, equipment, materials or supply companies, insurance or bonding organizations, and legal or financial organizations who represent of contractors, or other construction-related businesses
- Education: organizations that are educational institutions
- **Owners/Developers:** any individual or organization that owns and/or develops commercial or public property, whether for sale, lease, rent or personal use.
