





- The proportion of contraception providers who accepted Medicaid varied from 89% in Vermont to 55% in Texas
- While the percent of OB-GYNs providing IUDs was 93%, only 16% of family medicine, 3% of internal medicine, and less than 1% of pediatricians provides IUDs
