

Class 3 Wastewater Operator – Town of Corydon, IN

Open Date: August 1, 2025

End Date: Until filled.

Full time position with all municipal benefits. 90 day probationary period. Town of Corydon operates two wastewater treatment plants. A one million GPD oxidation ditch plant and a 500K GPD SBR plant. We also have 18 lift stations that fall under this department.

Collects multiple samples of untreated wastewater throughout the treatment process on a daily basis. Takes samples to the lab for testing and analysis. Checks supernatant and transfers sludge by pumping to appropriate tanks. Operates and adjusts pumps to ensure proper entry of chemicals into tanks and that settings and proper functioning occurs. Reads and records meter readings and prepares daily reports as assigned, makes appropriate adjustments in processing, and records any adjustments as required. Checks operations at headworks area, raw sewage pump station, grit removal chambers, roughing filters, trickling filters, oxidation ditch and all other equipment. Performs analyses on water samples including dissolved oxygen test, and suspended and settleable solids, pH, chlorine, nitrogen, etc. Enters operational data and NPDES permit data into computer. May operate sludge press and assist with disposal of solids. Check lift stations and record readings. May assist with pulling and replacing lift station pumps as needed. Other duties as assigned.

TRAINING/SKILLS - Ability to gain knowledge about wastewater treatment, all plant operations and equipment, and basic chemical testing of water quality. Understand the NPDES permit system and all applicable federal, state, and local regulations concerning plant operations and water quality. Ability to interpret and compile statistical data pertaining to plant operations. Ability to respond to emergency situations and interruption of normal treatment processes. Ability to walk up and down multiple flights of stairs and lift 50 pounds.

EXPERIENCE - Experience working in a Class 3 plant is required. Working with equipment and machinery, especially pumps, preferred. Experience working outdoors in all sorts of weather and in settings with potentially hazardous conditions, preferred.

Salary Range: \$25.88 - \$29.56

Position works under supervision of the Plant Superintendent, with possibility to become Plant Superintendent within one year and another salary adjustment at that time.
