

WHO WE ARE

The Alliance of Indiana Rural Water is a nonprofit membership association of over 1,000 water and wastewater systems related professionals Indiana's **ONLY** and is representative to the National Rural Water Association. NRWA is the nation's largest utility association with over 31,000 members. Our affiliation with NRWA provides the only cohesive voice representing water and wastewater systems, together leading the way in rural water legislation.

The Alliance staff provides training and onsite technical assistance on Safe Drinking Water Act compliance issues, public health protection (as it relates to drinking water), managerial issues, financial issues and operational issues to water and wastewater systems in Indiana that are under 10,000 in population. Training and onsite work is supported by federal contracts and grants that promote safe water for our communities. We are also funded by our membership.



The Alliance provides over 3,000 hours of FREE on-site technical assistance visits every year.

Each year, the Alliance trains over 2,000 people, offering over 575 hours of training during our one-day training sessions, conferences and other training opportunities.

AIRW canvases the entire state of Indiana with one purpose - to help rural communities. We are boots on the ground. We have USDA programs and EPA programs that specifically allow us to be on-site every day to assist utilities with anything they need.
