


Don't treat your drains like a trash can!

When inappropriate items are flushed down the toilet or poured down the drain, it damages your community wastewater treatment facility. This facility is not designed to remove items other than human waste. The City has to spend money to fix these issues, and as a result **your utility bill could go up to offset the cost of repairs!**

Do not flush or pour the following items:

- Baby wipes, *even if they say flushable!*
- Diapers
- Feminine products or their applicator
- Q tips, floss, plastics, or condoms
- Cotton swabs or cotton balls
- Kitty litter or pet waste
- Grease, oil, or foods
- Pharmaceuticals
- Cleaning products
- Towels, rags, sponges, or clothing
