To operate, monitor, and maintain the biological, chemical, mechanical, and hydraulic processes at the wastewater treatment plant and associated facilities. Conduct sampling and testing of the wastewater and biosolids for state and federal permit requirements along with optimizing plant operations.

Duties: Make daily rounds and inspections of treatment processes, components, and equipment. Regularly monitor plant functions through the reading and logging of gauges, graphs, meters, control panels, and computerized monitoring systems. Perform process control test and evaluate for optimizing plant efficiency. Collect samples from various treatment processes throughout the facility, run a variety of tests on them, and enter the results into a database for permit requirements, operational changes, and other miscellaneous equipment. Monitor and document lab chemical inventory and supplies. Perform facility and equipment preventative maintenance and emergency repairs. Calibrate lab, field, and online monitoring equipment. Operate machinery as necessary for plant operations. Perform building maintenance including custodial task. Operate, maintain, and repair lift stations. Operate, maintain, inspect and repair the collection system. Perform any other task that may be required for plant operations and/or state and federal permits.

Working Environment: Work is performed outside and inside both day and night under varying and extreme weather conditions; job includes working weekends and holidays. Work requires the ability to understand and follow both written and oral instructions. The position requires the ability to work under time constraints and in confined spaces with the use of appropriate safety equipment.

Requirements: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade with course work in mathematics, chemistry, and biology. The applicant should be proficient at data entry especially in Microsoft Office. The applicant should also possess good organizational and communication skills. Possession of a valid Indiana Driver's License is required. Possession of a current and valid Indiana Class 1 Operators license is required

The selection process will include complete job description review, personal interview, criminal background check, functional capacity evaluation, and substance screening.
