Speaker Ideas

After you register for Project SAFE, you will need to book a safety speaker to come speak at your event. You choose the topic that is relevant to your residents and then invite an expert on that topic to educate your residents on it.

TIPS:

- ✓ Book your speaker early before their schedules fill up. Summer is a busy season, especially for pool safety.
- ✓ Schedule your speaker to present within 30 minutes of your event start time. Ask them to arrive 15 minutes before they are scheduled to speak and allow them to leave right after.

SPEAKER IDEAS - ALL TOPICS:

- Ask a local business that is an expert in your safety topic if they'd be willing to speak to your residents in exchange for advertising their business.
- Check with city or state organizations or non-profits dedicated to your safety topic. Ask to speak with their community outreach person.
- You! If the speakers are unavailable, ask them to provide you with some safety brochures or handouts and you can be your own speaker. Safety brochures and handouts can also be found online to be printed.
