 - **>**501 (c) (3) organization (public charity) incorporated in Washington DC
 - Founded as the research arm of the International Slurry Surfacing Association







- Board of Directors and Officers

 - Educate public about pavement maintenance

- SAFETEA-LU reauthorization
 - ➤ Capital Hill visits- over 70 in 2011
 - **▶** Participate in the ARTBA Fly-In
 - ➤ Instrumental in getting preservation language into both the Senate bill, MAP-21, and the House bill, The American Energy & Infrastructure Jobs Act

- National Pavement Preservation Media

- Assist with the organization of the 2nd
