Tenants, Residents in Buildings Across the Region Participate in *AOBA's Fall Food Drive* to Benefit Capital Area Food Bank

The area's property management community collectively gathered **more than 2,000 items** of much needed food from generous tenants and residents to give to the **Capital Area Food Bank** (CAFB), rated as one of the "20 Best Charities" in the region.

AOBA's Fall Food Drive – a region-wide community outreach project, engaged approximately **150** buildings – both commercial office buildings and residential apartment communities – in collecting non-perishable food items during the first two weeks of October.
