**Posters:** A research poster is a physical display of scholarly work, usually reporting empirical research.

Score	Criteria
5	<ul> <li>Abstract clearly describes the purpose and design of the study and briefly summarizes the results.</li> <li>Data are complete.</li> <li>A PDF of the completed poster is included.</li> </ul>
4	<ul> <li>Abstract clearly describes the purpose of the study.</li> <li>Complete baseline data and one treatment data point for one participant are included.</li> </ul>
3	<ul> <li>Abstract clearly describes the purpose of the study.</li> <li>Fake data are provided to demonstrate the expected results (clearly labeled as fake data) and a description of the intended timeline for completion is provided.</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>Abstract vaguely states the purpose of the study.</li> <li>A description of the intended timeline for completion is provided.</li> </ul>
1	<ul> <li>Abstract is insufficient for review (not enough content, too short)</li> <li>No statement is provided related to timeline for completion; no data are provided.</li> </ul>
