DETAILS:

Applications for the study trip are now being accepted by Elizabeth Darocha Berenz (elizabeth.berenz@artstor.org) and the last day we will accept them is May 24, 2010. Applicants will be selected on a first-come first-served basis. The study tour will be able to accommodate 12 ARLIS/NA members. Unfortunately, spouses and partners will not be able to join the participants on the trip.

Study trip applicants will be notified by June 1, 2010 if they are accepted for the trip or if they are an alternate.

COSTS:

There is no fee, other than a \$350 deposit, which must accompany all applications. This deposit will be applicable to housing and local travel expenses. The deposit will be returned to applicants who are not accepted for the trip.

Participants are responsible for airfare (round-trip to/from the UK) and some local transportation. Please also be prepared to cover most of your meals and miscellaneous expenses.

HOUSING:

Participants will stay in University College London housing (http://www.ucl.ac.uk/residences/) located in central London, which will cost approximately £41/night (singles only). All rooms are en-suite. Application deposits will be used toward housing fees. Participants are responsible for additional housing costs not covered by the deposit.
