



27th Annual George Wittenborn Memorial Book Award Winners

Atlanta, Georgia - On April 29, 2007, the 27th Annual George Wittenborn Memorial Book Awards were presented at the annual conference of the Art Libraries Society of North America (ARLIS/NA). Established in 1981 to honor the memory of premier New York City art book dealer and publisher George Wittenborn, the awards are given each year to North American art publications which represent the highest standards of content, documentation, layout, and format. Two outstanding books published in 2006 were selected to receive the 27th Annual George Wittenborn Memorial Book Award:

- *Prayers and Portraits: Unfolding the Netherlandish Diptych*. John Oliver Hand, Catherine A. Metzger, Ron Spronk. National Gallery of Art, Washington; Koninklijk Museum voor Schone Kunsten, Antwerp, in association with Harvard University Art Museums, Cambridge, and Yale University Press, New Haven and London.
- *American Indian Horse Masks*. Mike Cowdrey and Ned & Jody Martin. Hawk Hill Press, Nicasio, California.
