ARLIS/NA ENDORSES CAA'S CODE OF BEST PRACTICES IN FAIR USE FOR THE VISUAL ARTS

The ARLIS/NA Executive Board endorsed the College Art Association's *Code of Best Practices in Fair Use for the Visual Arts* after careful consideration of the Code during the June 18, 2015 board meeting. Kristen Regina, President of ARLIS/NA, stated: "The code is an important document that will advance visual arts scholarship and creative practice in this digital age." The Executive Board agreed with the ARLIS/NA Public Policy Committee's assessment that the Code is a strong step away from a permissions culture that hinders many members of the larger community.
