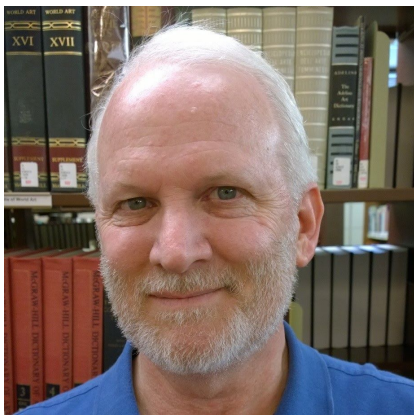


ARLIS/NA Announces Recipients of the 2020 Member Research Awards

The Art Libraries Society of North America (ARLIS/NA) is pleased to announce the recipients of the ARLIS/NA 2020 Member Research Awards.

The Worldwide Books Award for Publications recognizes outstanding publications by ARLIS/NA individual members in librarianship or visual resources curatorship and the arts. By recognizing special achievement in these areas this award acknowledges and encourages scholarly publication by the ARLIS/NA membership. The 2020 winner is *Comics and Critical Librarianship: Reframing the Narrative in Academic Libraries*, edited by Olivia Piepmeier and Stephanie Grimm.



The H. W. Wilson Foundation Research Award supports research activities by ARLIS/NA individual members in the fields of librarianship, visual resources curatorship, and the arts. The award encourages the professional development of the membership in their capacities as information intermediaries and as subject specialists in the arts. The winner for 2020 is Robert Craig Bunch for his project *Dreams, Visions, Other Worlds: Interviews with Texas Artists*, a monograph underway with Texas A&M University Press.
