WESTFORD, Massachusetts – The Art Libraries Society of North America (ARLIS/NA) is pleased to announce this year's winners of the ARLIS/NA H. W. Wilson Foundation Research Award.

The H. W. Wilson Foundation Research Award supports research activities by ARLIS/NA individual members in the fields of librarianship, visual resources curatorship, and the arts. The award encourages the professional development of members in their capacities as information intermediaries and as subject specialists in the arts. The winners for 2022 are:

- Sandra Cowan for her project “The Research Methods of Artists,” which investigates the processes that artists use to achieve creative work. Cowan plans to present her work at the next ARLIS Conference and to publish it as a journal article.
- Lelland Reed for her project “Curating the B-Roll: Scoping Practice of Unedited and Raw Audiovisual Materials in Memory Institutions.” The H.W. Wilson Award will support the creation of a podcast that will disseminate the project’s findings in an engaging way that is accessible to the ARLIS and broader library and archives communities.
