

#### A3 Process


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A3 Steps	PDCA Cycle
1.Background – Opportunity / Problem Statement	
2. Current Condition	
3. Target Condition "The Goal"	Plan
4. Analysis	
5. Countermeasures	
6 Implementation Plan	Do
7.Confirm Effectiveness / Follow Up Actions	Check Act

## Waiting for Fork Trucks






- Carts instead fork trucks

## Lean Implementation Tips

- Use your Customer Expertise
  - Some will consult for free
- Must have Upper Management Support
- Get Production Leadership on Board
  - Take plant tours of facilities
  - Change in mindset
- Have a Captain and a Champion
  - Team Leader and Upper Management rep
- Set achievable milestones
  - Base Hits not Home Runs
- Meet and review regularly or lose momentum (weekly, bi-weekly)
- Keep it Simple
- Take Before and After Pictures
- Celebrate Small Wins
  - Pizza, gift cards, T-shirts
