# Program overview





**Length of Program:** Two Years.

Three Semesters of College and 3,000 hours at work.

**Eligibility:** Recent high school graduates and adult learners.

**Tuition:** Free. Plus, you'll get PAID to attend class. **Starting Pay:** \$16.00. Periodic increases, every 6 month.

Pay after completion: \$19.00 minimum.

**6 College classes:** 13 Credits total. Earn a Certificate in Mechatronics Engineering

Technology and a Journeyman Certificate

**Schedule:** Class one day a week. Work four days a week at one of

the partner companies.

**Stackable:** Want to keep learning after your Apprenticeship? These classes

can count toward an associate degree at Blue Ridge.

# Setup of an Apprenticeship program



- Find College-Partner for the educational part
- Find Industry Partners to form a consortium (grow momentum / classroom size)
- Create an agreeable class schedule to meet DOL / State requirements
- Decide on rules (pay structure, bonus payments, marketing, hiring, etc.
- Market within your local school system (especially middle and high school)
- Make it exciting to become part of the program (signing day, outfit, etc.)
- Create a new workforce legacy

## Timeline of Apprenticeships in Henderson County



- 2019 1<sup>st</sup> class of Industrial Manufacturing Technicians
- 2020 2<sup>nd</sup> class of Industrial Manufacturing Technicians
  1<sup>st</sup> class of Business and Banking Apprenticeship
- 2021 3<sup>rd</sup> class of Industrial Manufacturing Technicians
  2<sup>nd</sup> class of Business and Banking Apprenticeship

#### Fast forward:

- 2024 16 different apprenticeship programs (mostly technical trades) are offered in Henderson County
  - 14 programs are targeted to Highschool Graduates

# Creating employment legacy at Elkamet



2019 – 2022 15 Highschool Graduates started the Apprenticeship program

8 graduated the program

6 are still employed at Elkamet

1 former Elkamet Apprentice went on to get his Bachelor degree

### Retention rate of 75% with graduates

2023 3 apprentices started – 2 are still successfully in the program

2024 3 apprentices are already hired for the fall start – most likely we will employ:

3 to 6 Industrial Manufacturing Process Technicians

1 Electrician Apprentice

1 Business and Banking Apprentice
