Why submit a nomination?

- Celebrates excellence in alliance management
- Honors the teams and companies that exemplify great alliance practice
- Motivate your alliance team in the quest for excellence
- Brings visibility and accolades through press releases and media
- Be recognized by your partners and industry peers
- Contribute to a body of knowledge that promotes excellence in the profession





Award Categories

Alliance for Social Corporate Responsibility

✓ Profound, measurable and positive social impact; profit is OK

Alliance Program Excellence

- Corporate capability for successful alliances
- ✓ Process, training, culture, leadership that enables repeatable alliance success

Individual Alliance Excellence

- ✓ Emerging Alliance
- ✓ Longstanding Alliance

Innovative Best Alliance Practice

✓ New process, tool, or alliance management approach that demonstrated success

Best Ecosystem Solution

✓ A group of at least four partners that jointly deliver an innovative solution for a specific client/customer or set of clients/customers

Awards Criteria




- ✓ What makes this alliance/program/practice stand out?
- ✓ What new lessons does it offer?



- ✓ What is innovative about this alliance/program/practice?
- ✓ How might this innovation help other alliances?



- ✓ What are the qualitative and quantitative measures of success?
- ✓ How did this alliance/program/practice create strategic value?



✓ How have the best practices, ideas and lessons been shared with the alliance community?



Evaluation Process

- 1. Judges are alliance experts: academics, practitioners, and consultants
- 2. Each nomination is reviewed individually and kept confidential
- 3. Nominations are evaluated based on the criteria for each category
- 4. Supporting materials are also considered
- 5. Each nomination is scored across the criteria for a total score
- 6. The highest score wins!
- 7. Accepted nominations are notified by the end of January; finalists are announced at Summit on April 3; winners are announced during the virtual awards ceremony and fireside chat

Tips

- Consult the awards page for nomination examples, tools, testimonials to help build your winning nomination
- Make use of the short submission form to get early feedback
- Review categories carefully and choose the best fit
- Obtain input from partners & alliance team members
- Give us specific examples. What challenges did you face? How did you overcome? What were the results?
- Provide supporting materials
- Focus on the alliance and partnering guiding principles which are the foundation of ASAP best practices
- On average a submission requires around 1,500 words, excluding figures and supporting materials



What Not To Do

- Do not have your PR team write the nomination
- Do not focus solely on outcomes...we are interested in the HOW & WHY
- Do not omit 'how you are different' from common alliance practices and competencies
- Do not submit the same nomination to more than one category
- Do not wait until the last minute to submit
- Do not focus on the good stuff only: how you solve challenges is at least as interesting
- Do not underestimate the importance of the criteria of openness


